Safety and Environment

- No significant safety events at either site
- Security event at Berkeley – confirmed false alarm
- ONR event follow up x2 - O&B
- Robust Covid arrangements remain in place despite national restrictions easing – no issues on site
- Continued good relationships with emergency services and emergency exercises practiced on site across teams.



Brk Security event

- Unexpected parcel arrived on site
- Police were informed and attended site
- The area around the package was cleared to 100m; including areas of adjacent SGS campus.
- Following checks the EoD on site confirmed the package was safe.

ONR event follow up x2

- Oldbury – inadvertent removal of skip crane striker plates during deplanting works – found by site staff and reported during routine inspection, investigation complete (on and off site).
- Berkeley – failure of cross site transporter brake – reported by site staff and site investigation complete. ONR follow up report in progress.

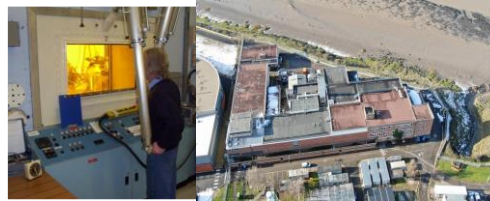

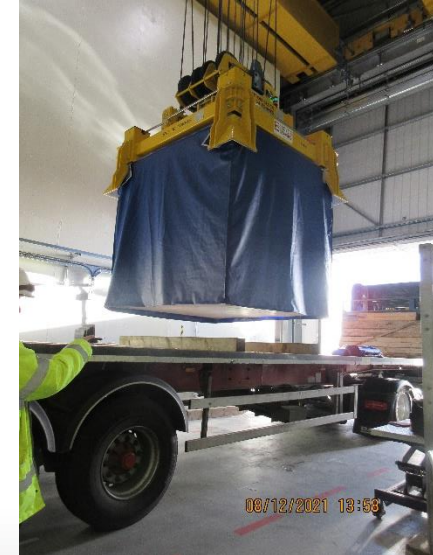


Site Focus – Return to Retrievals

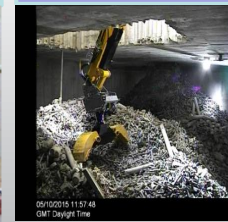

132kv building

- Previously used for transferring the power generated from the site onto the National Grid
- The relay room has already been de-planted
- 3300m² of asbestos to clear
- Demolition is currently planned for May 2022



Socio-economic

- £4,500 to SGS college for radioactive study materials
 - £10,000 to Stonehouse 'Read with Me' project
 - £1,000 to Dursley CofE for play equipment
 - £90,000 over three years to Envision
- Redundant equipment donated to various local causes from OTC.
 - Visitor car park will be used for a one off running event on 24 April.
