Safety and compliance

- 2,120 days of decommissioning work delivered without a Lost Time Accident (DACR / TRIR = 0)
- Project Safety Review targets exceeded
- 658 opportunities to learn (LCFs) raised and 18 learning / innovation briefs issued in last year
- Covid-19 controls remain successful
- 1,069 days since last environmental non-compliance

Four accidents at DNA requiring first aid in 2021 /22

- 3 hand injuries
- 1 leg injury

- Wet waste transfer facility conversion for resin retrieval and commissioning
- Pathfinder DCIC resin retrieval, dessicant and catalyst retrieval, cyclone dust retrieval and vacation of reactor buildings
- Relocation of facilities to make way for the boilers and ancillary plant removal project

- Boilers and ancillary plant removal enablers

- Multiple asset care projects

LLW waste operations key successes

- Waste Operations had a Joint Waste Management Plan (JWMP) target of 13 LLW disposals for FY21/22 this target was successfully achieved

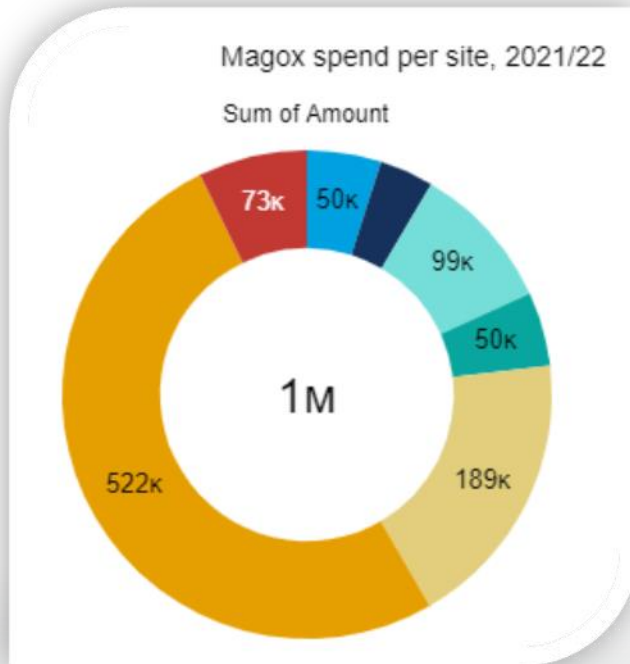


LLW waste operations key successes

- Magnox Soc-ec Funding remains at £1,020,035 with £171,750 multi year funding already committed
- Good Neighbour funding raised to £2,000; however £6,000 allocation per site remains unchanged
