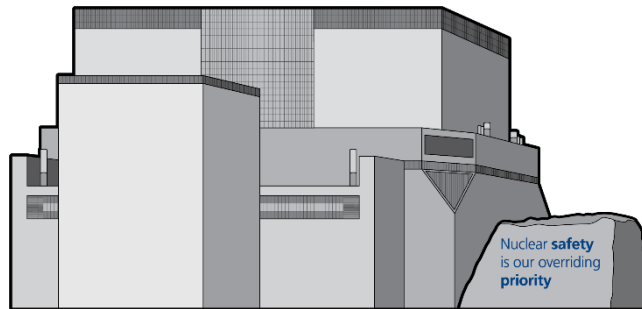


About Me



Safety and Environmental Performance

- ❑ Over **15** years since our last nuclear reportable event
- ❑ Over **6** years since the last lost time incident to an EDF Energy employee
- ❑ Over **2** years since the last lost time incident to a contract partner
- ❑ **1** environmental reportable event in **12** years
- ❑ **4** minor first aid injuries since the October SSG meeting
- ❑ Further improvements and enhancements made to environmental protection systems following generator transformer 7 event on 19 August 2021. Comprehensive investigation into the event is complete, and regulatory warning letter has been served.
- ❑ Continually to monitor boiler reheater defect
- ❑ Water in Active Effluent Treatment Plant



Generation Performance

17 October 2021 to 12 February 2022

Station output: **2.162 TWh**

Reactor 3: 1.262 TWh

Reactor 4: 0.900 TWh

Storm Eunice: salt and other dust sediment was blown onto the National Grid sub station – both reactors were shutdown.

Apart from the shutdown mentioned above, reactor 3 had operated at nominal load throughout the reporting period, and had been online since 25 October 2021.

Reactor 4 was shutdown on 12 November for a planned 30 day graphite inspection and maintenance programme. 31 channels were inspected, and results were within expectation. The unit returned to service on 19 December for its final 6 month operational run.
