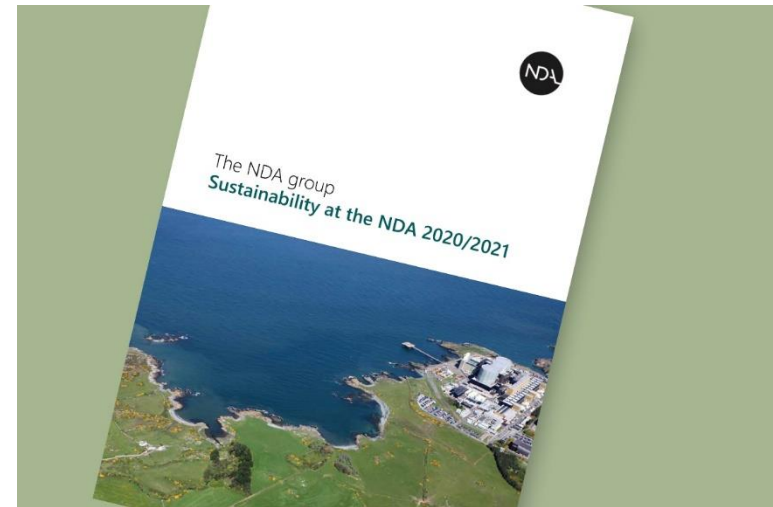
COVID-19 Update

NDA Update

Supply Chain Event

- Largest event of its kind in Europe
- 10,000 visitors from more than 20 countries
- NIA DECOMM 2022 – 20 July

Mission Progress Report

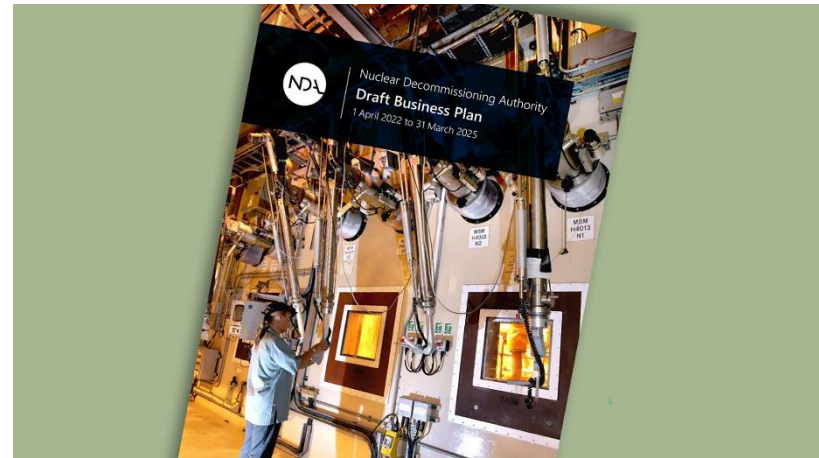
- Published in November – can make hard copies available
- This report demonstrates how much progress has been made in our mission since 2005, and how much further is left to go over the next 120-plus years.
- Progress and goals have been aligned with those in Strategy 4, published in March 2021.



NDA Update

Business Plan 2022-2025

- Sets out main activities to advance clean-up and decommissioning work over the next 3 years
- This consultation ended on 31 January
- We will forward feedback in due course



NDA Update

NDA to decommission Advanced Gas Reactors

- Directed by government to take on future ownership of seven EDF AGR sites for decommissioning
- Magnox Ltd will be responsible for decommissioning the seven sites following defueling
- Testament to skills, knowledge and experience in NDA group – and government confidence in NDA's capability
- National Audit Office published a report on the agreement on 28 January. The Public Accounts Committee convened a hearing on 7 January and NDA CEO David Peattie was called to give evidence.

NDA Update

Nuclear Waste Services

- NDA new waste division launched on 31 January.
- The last of the 'four pillars' to come into being.
- Nuclear Waste Services brings together Radioactive Waste Management (RWM), Low Level Waste Repository (LLWR) and the NDA's Integrated Waste Management team
- Its Executive Committee is drawn from the existing three organisations
- CEO is NDA's Corhyn Parr
- Likely to be little immediate change for the majority of employees
- Departments and functions will look to integrate over time.

NDA Update

Allerdale Community Partnership

- RWM welcomes the formation of the Allerdale Community Partnership
- Third Community Partnership in West Cumbria
- Marks the starting point in an exploratory, fact-finding and discussion process with the local community about hosting a GDF
- Theddlethorpe has announced its local Search Area. Working Group is looking to move the process forward over the coming months

- Virtual conference where stakeholders asked questions and heard panels on a live streaming platform
