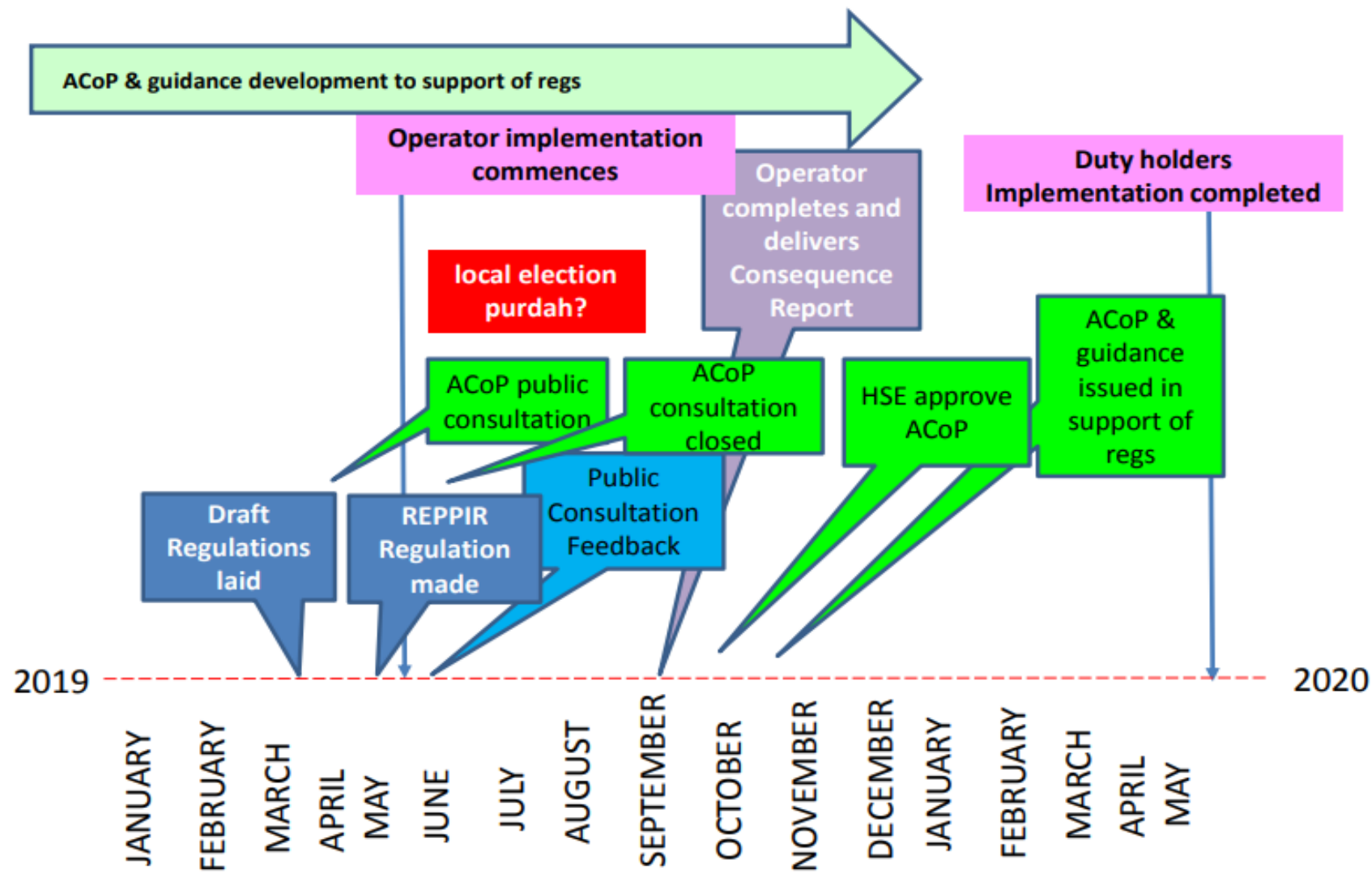


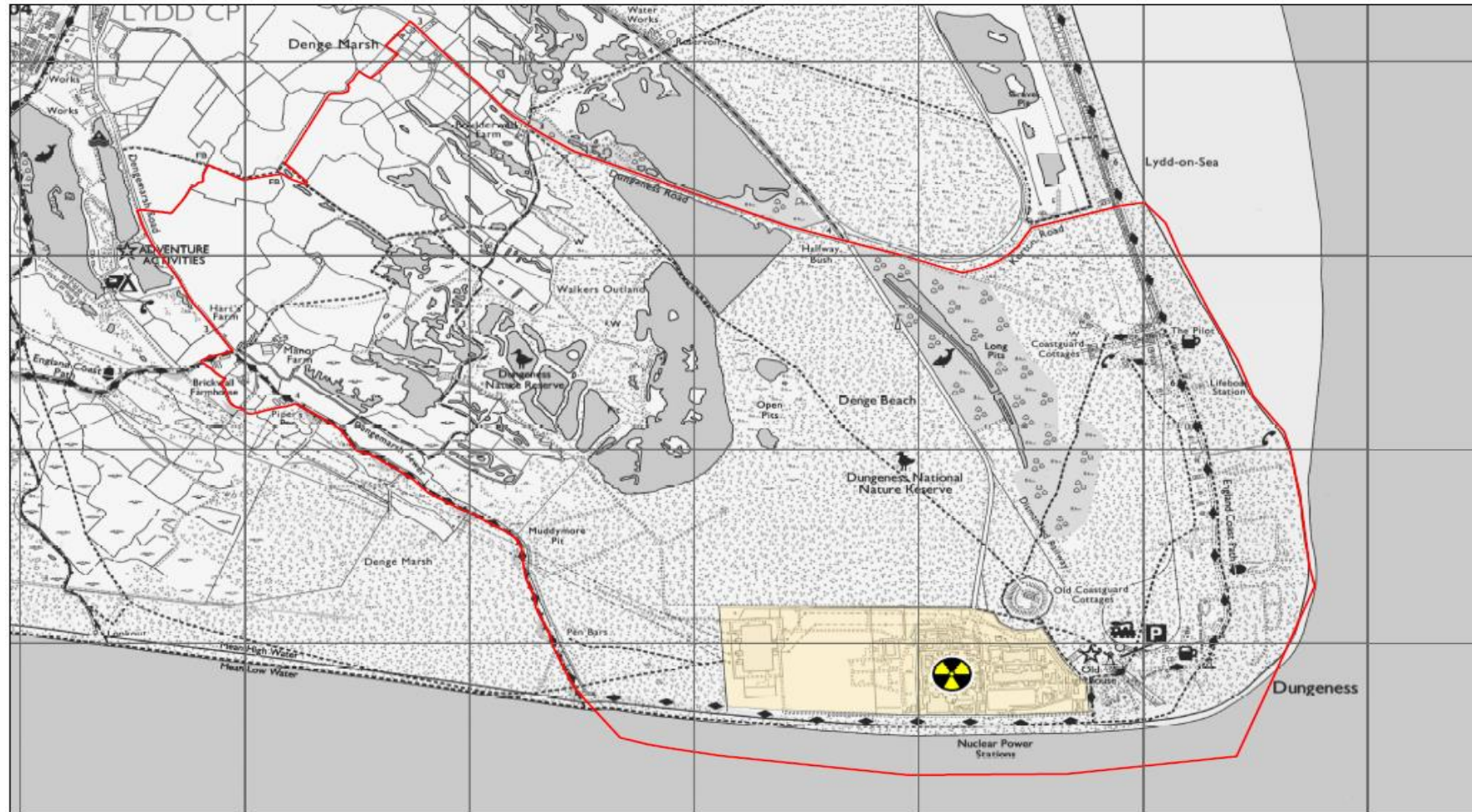

- DEPZ boundary

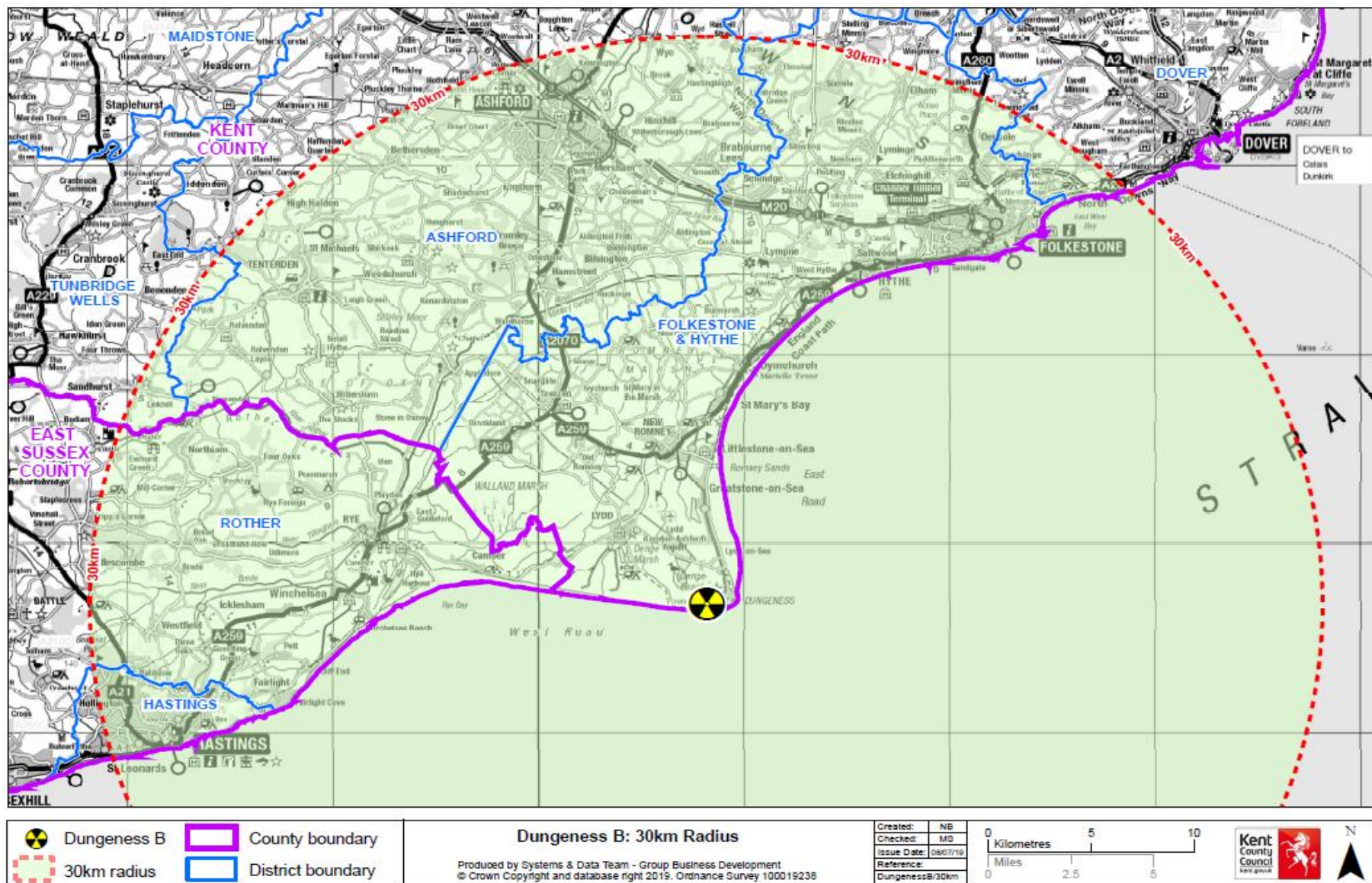

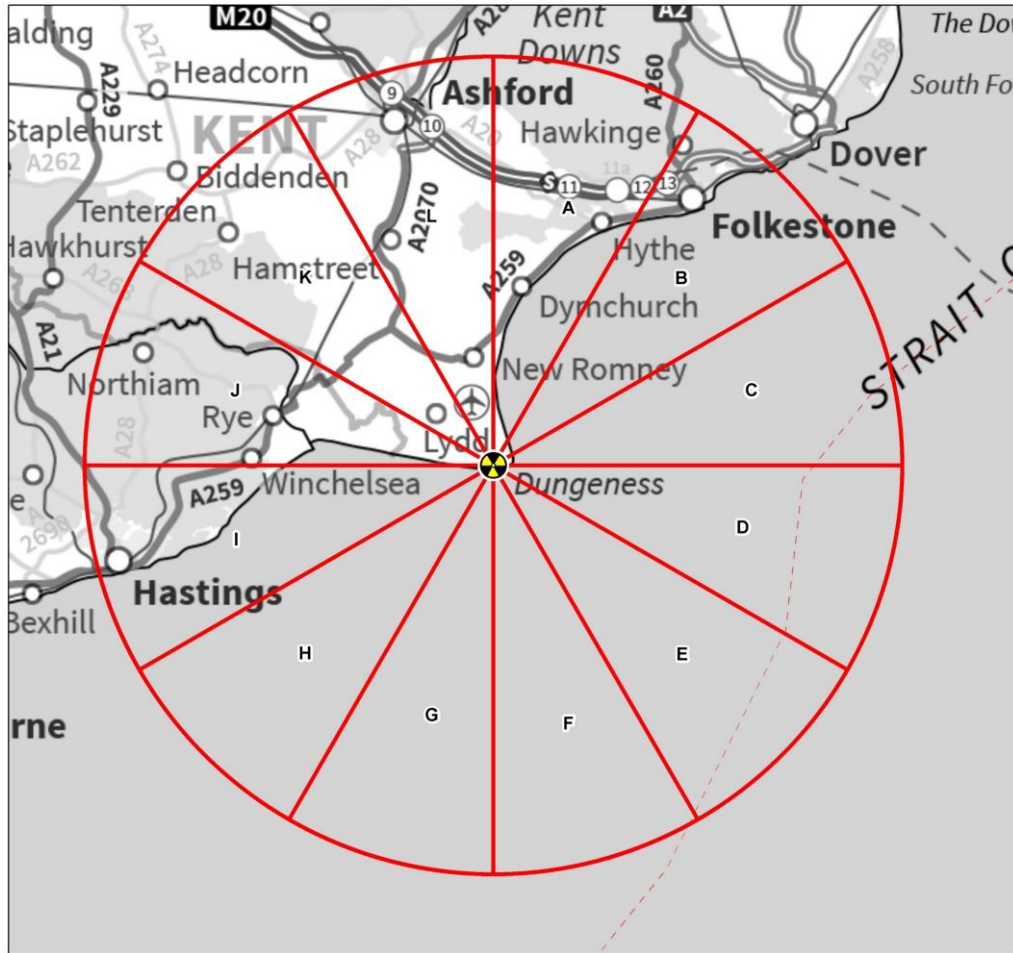

30km Outline Planning Zone





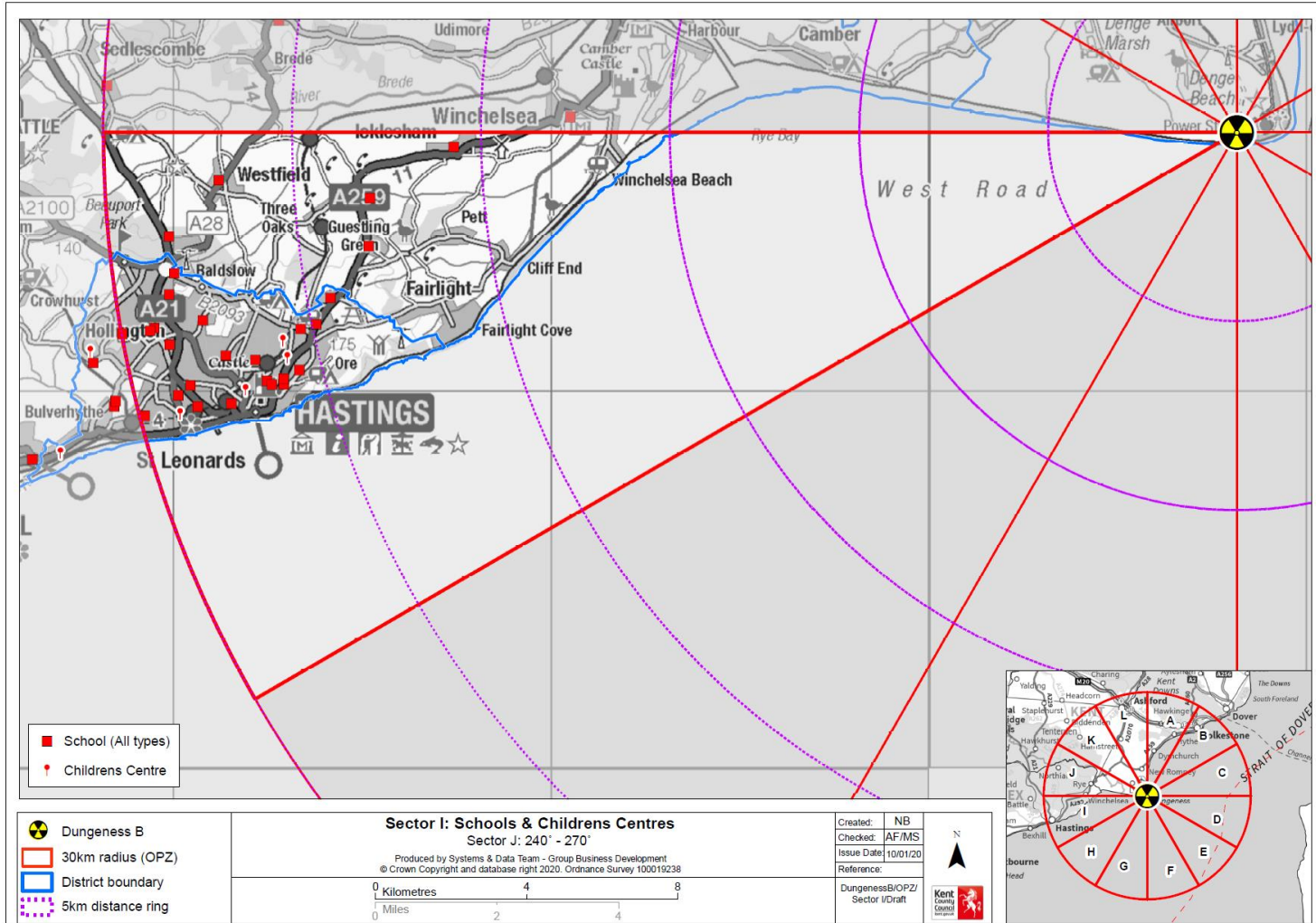
OPZ Sectors

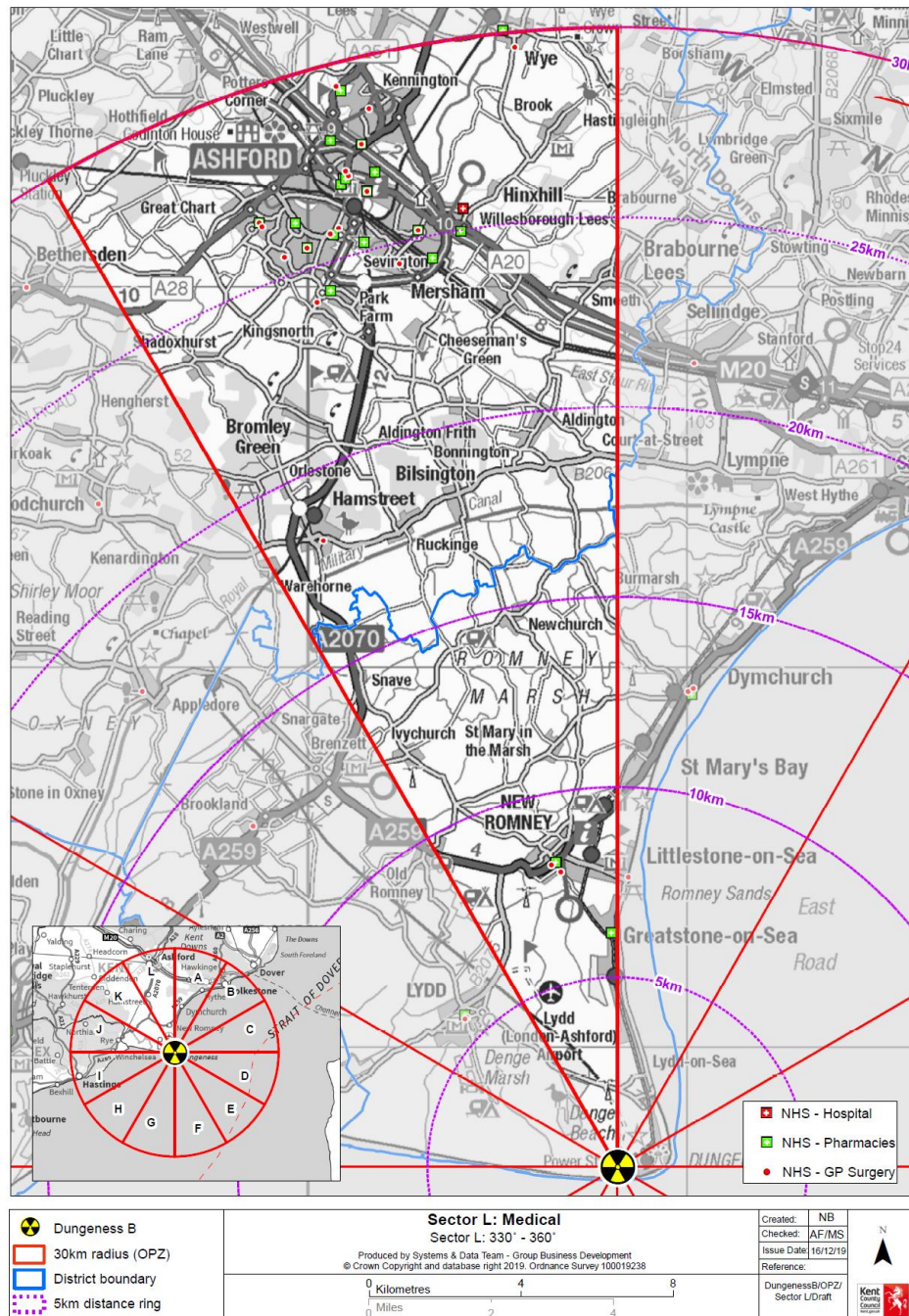
- 30km OPZ split into 12 sectors
- These match Met Office sectors
- Provides continuity with Multi-Agency partners

Planning

Analysis of assets within each sector

Improves ability to plan for varying scenarios





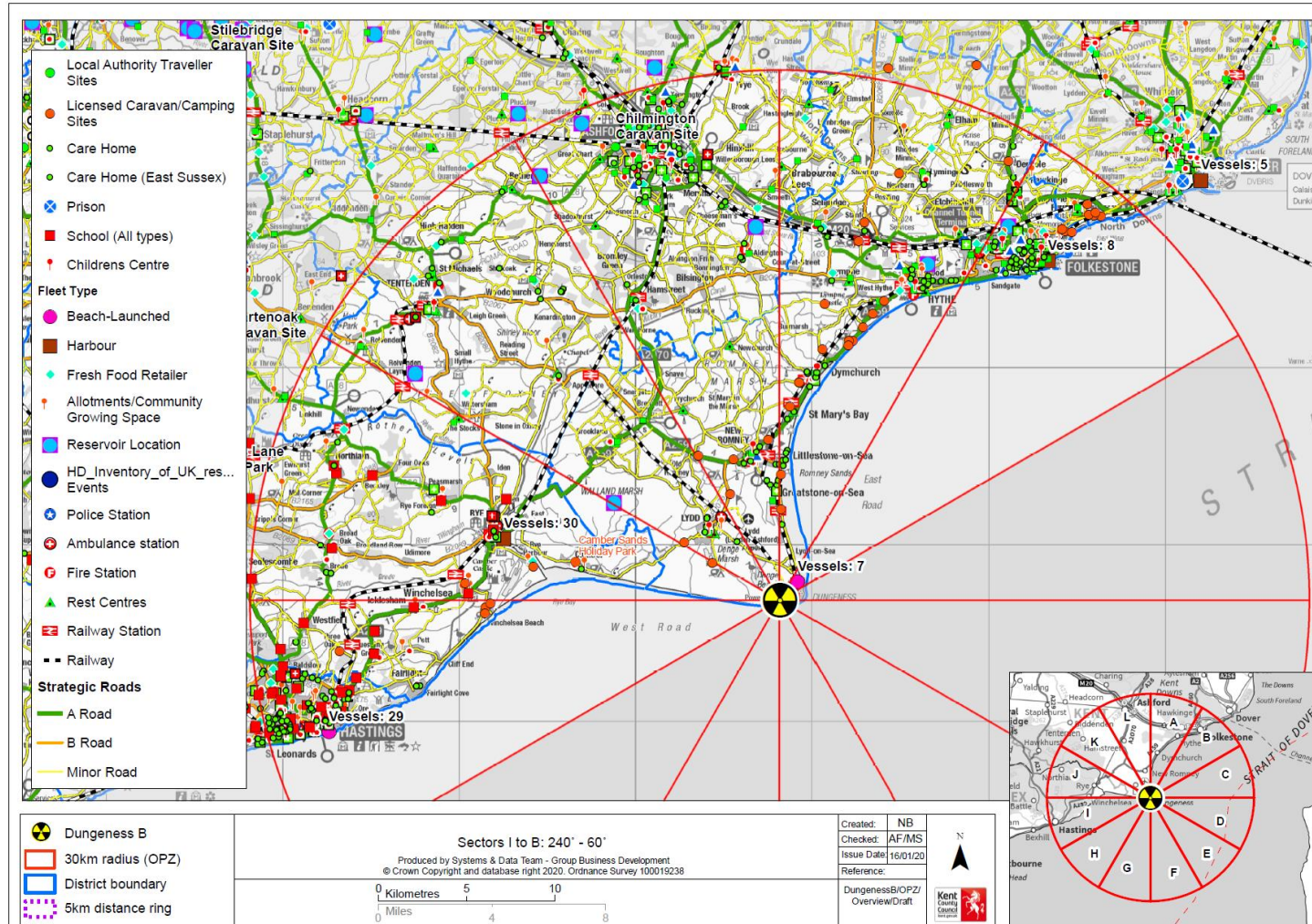
Grouping Assets

- Assets/ infrastructure are grouped into themes
- Improves visual data presentation
- Easy to identify 'clustering' of similar assets

Scale

Sectors provide data at a usable scale

Risk losing clarity if viewing too many datasets at too small a scale
