NDA Update

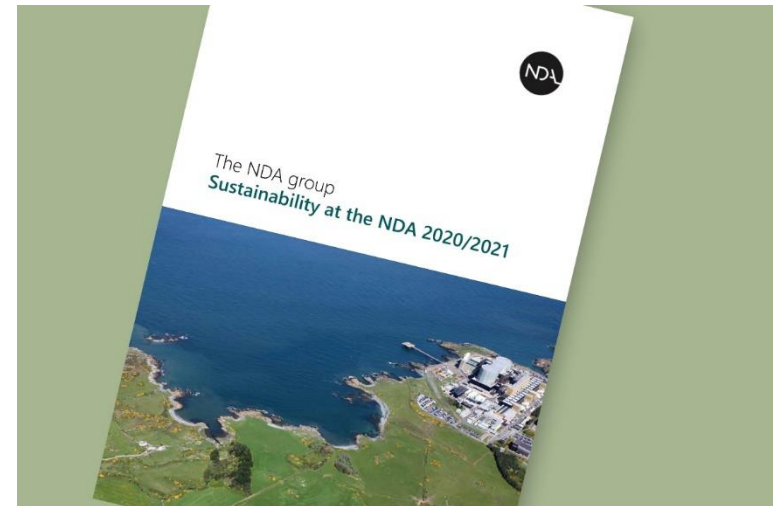
COVID-19 Update

- Directive to work from home for the time being, with only essential travel
- As in society, cases among the workforce have risen, but not fundamentally affected work on sites – or compromised approach to safety and security
- Offices are open - will continue to adopt a mix of home and office working where appropriate
- Review of progressive return to more face-to-face external engagement due to be reviewed next month, and based on discussion with stakeholders

NDA Update

NDA Sustainability Strategy and Report

- First NDA Sustainability Report published on 8 March
- A new group sustainability strategy is about to go in to production for external release
- Investing in people, communities & protecting environment for long-term
- Identifies key opportunities and projects to improve sustainability across NDA group
- NDA Group supported participation at COP26 and produced Net Zero report



NDA Update

Mission Progress Report

- Published in November – can make hard copies available
- This report demonstrates how much progress has been made in our mission since 2005, and how much further is left to go over the next 120-plus years.
- Progress and goals have been aligned with those in Strategy 4, published in March 2021.
- NDA Business Plan consultation – will forward feedback in due course



NDA Update

Nuclear Waste Services

- NDA's waste division on target to launch 31 January 2022, bringing together LLWR and RWM under a common executive team & identity
- Will be known as Nuclear Waste Services, with the logo and identity still in development
- Day-to-day work for the majority of employees will remain unchanged. Departments and functions will be looking at integrating beyond launch
- The new executive team do not take up positions until 31 January.

NDA Update

New Appointments

- Adrienne Kelbie CBE (pictured) has been appointed Chair of Nuclear Waste Services.
- She was appointed on 1 Jan for a period of 3 years
- Previously CEO for two terms at ONR
- Separately, Chris Train has been appointed as non-exec director of the NDA from 10 Jan for 3 years
- Chris has experience at National Grid and Transco and specialises in regulation



NDA Update

NDA to decommission Advanced Gas Reactors

- Directed by government to take on future ownership of seven EDF AGR sites for decommissioning
- Magnox Ltd will be responsible for decommissioning the seven sites following defueling
- Testament to skills, knowledge and experience in NDA group – and government confidence in NDA's capability
- We look forward to working with EDF Energy to ensure the seamless transfer of stations in the coming years

NDA Update

Theddlethorpe Working Group/Mid Copeland Community Partnership

- RWM welcomes the formation of Theddlethorpe Working Group
- Provides a platform for starting local discussions on the possible siting of a geological disposal facility (GDF)
- Marks the starting point in an exploratory, fact-finding and discussion process
- Mid-Copeland Community Partnership formed
