

Magnox Socio-economic Funding in the Community

2019/20 Socio-economic scheme update

Magnox are pleased to have supported 15 applications from communities surrounding Wylfa site this financial year. This equates to £176,841 through the scheme.

In addition, a further £1,045,000 NDA direct funding has also been committed to the area with £400,000 for Menter Môn's Morlais Tidal Project over two years, an additional £150,000 for the Cemaes CIC Capel Bethlehem Project and £495,000 over three years, to Isle of Anglesey County Council to assist in delivering the North Anglesey Regeneration Plan.

New groups that have benefited from the Good Neighbour level funding this year are:



Anglesey and Gwynedd School Sports Awards received £150 for the Primary School of the Year award. Stuart Law attended the ceremony held in Beaumaris to present the award. Over 300 people attended the evening.

Moelfre Rowing Club were awarded £780 to purchase a new trailer for their sea sculling boat. This will provide at least four opportunities for club volunteers to train as coaches and involves the use of the boat to offer the sport to primary and secondary school children.

Cemaes Boat Club received £550 to purchase a walkie talkie and new life jackets for the 14 crew members of the historic Charles Henry Ashley lifeboat.

Blagur Haf Caergeiliog had £350 towards outdoor educational play equipment. The toddlers will benefit from two new rear step plate trikes, a pumping station, plastic water channeling gutters and a trundle bike.

Amlwch Pre-school Playgroup, Cylch Meithrin Amlwch and Benllech Playgroup all benefitted from a contribution towards education equipment too.

Mon Actif were awarded £1,000 to host four Magnox sponsored one day events at the Leisure Centres across Anglesey. They will offer football, swimming, athletics, rugby, netball, tennis and a variety of multi-sport games. The funding will help 25 young people gain a Community Sports Leaders Level 2 Qualification.

Parys Training were able to purchase ten Windows 10 desktop pc's with £1,000 from the scheme. It is anticipated this will assist with training for over 150 individuals using the facilities.

Larger transformational projects supported:

Anglesey Column Trust formed to restore the Grade II* listed Marquess of Anglesey Column. The £966,000 project will restore the column as a tourist attraction and remodel the cottage as a visitor education centre and café. The £70,000 contribution from Magnox will fund the bilingual interpretation scheme. The project aims to open by September 2021 and anticipates ten employment opportunities, over 40 voluntary opportunities, new businesses created with the visitor centre and café and engage with 26 local schools, Bangor University and Grŵp Llandrillo Menai offering educational programmes.

NDA directly funded:

Morlais Tidal Energy Project

Morlais held a supply chain event in MSParc on 5 March which was very well attended. In the morning Llinos Medi Huws, Leader of Anglesey County Council, spoke. Selkie, Bangor University and Minesto gave presentations and Gerallt Llewelyn Jones gave a progress update on the Morlais project.



Local businesses had an opportunity to present in the afternoon closing with a Q and A session.

Menter Môn is currently building a Supply Chain database which holds almost 400 Welsh businesses, of which 146 from North Wales. Many are experienced local companies who have benefitted from working with Magnox and Anglesey Aluminium in the past.

Menter Môn received NDA direct funding of £400,000 over two years for Morlais B - the next phase of the project. This is progressing well: consent and licensing applications have been submitted to Welsh Government Planning Inspectorate and Natural Resources Wales, awaiting a decision from Welsh Ministers. If approved, this will release £27k European funding to which they require £9m match funding for the infrastructure build.

New North Anglesey Regeneration Fund launched

A new North Anglesey Regeneration Fund, managed by Anglesey County Council has opened, offering grants to help businesses and support local events.



As part of the £495,000 funding committed by the NDA, a new £50,000 funding pot is available for small grants of up to £5,000 to help businesses and community groups in the Talybolion and Twrcelyn wards, and the community of Moelfre (as identified in the North Anglesey Economic Regeneration Plan).

The fund will provide small grants for suitable projects aimed at supporting economic growth, promoting the Welsh language, creating jobs and improving skills, partnership working, protecting the environment and creating sustainable communities.

The fund is split into two rounds; applications must be submitted by 31 March 2020 for the first round and by 31 May 2020 for the second.

The current scheme is now closed for new applications as we transition to a new 'One NDA' system from 1 April 2020. The system is currently being tested. Further details will be available soon on the .gov website.

Cyllid Economaidd-gymdeithasol Magnox yn y Gymuned

Y diweddaraaf am gynllun economaidd-gymdeithasol 2019/20

Mae Magnox yn falch o fod wedi cefnogi 15 o geisiadau gan gymunedau o amgylch safle Wylfa yn ystod y flwyddyn ariannol hon. Mae hyn yn cyfateb i £176, 841 drwy'r cynllun.

Yn ogystal â hyn, mae £1,045,000 o gyllid uniongyrchol gan yr NDA wedi cael ei neilltuo i'r ardal: £400,000 ar gyfer Prosiect Llanw Morlais, Menter Môn, dros ddwy flynedd, £150,000 arall ar gyfer Prosiect Capel Bethlehem CIC Cemaes a £495,000 dros dair blynedd i Gyngor Sir Ynys Môn i'w gynorthwyo i gyflawni Cynllun Adfywio Gogledd Ynys Môn.

Dyma rai o'r grwpiau newydd sydd wedi elwa o arian lefel Cymydog Da eleni:



Cafodd **Gwobrau Chwaraeon Ysgolion Gwynedd a Môn** £150 ar gyfer gwobr Ysgol Gynradd y Flwyddyn. Roedd Stuart Law yn bresennol yn y seremoni ym Miwmares i gyflwyno'r wobr. Daeth dros 300 o bobl i'r noson.

Glwb Rhwyfo Moelfre Rhoddwyd £780 i'r clwb i brynu trelar newydd ar gyfer eu cwch rhwyfo ar y môr. Bydd hyn yn rhoi o leiaf bedwar cyfle i wirfoddolwyr y clwb hyfforddi fel hyfforddwyr ac mae'n golygu defnyddio'r cwch i gynnig y gamp i blant ysgol gynradd ac uwchradd.

Clwb Cychod Cemaes Cafodd y clwb £550 i brynu 'walkie talkie' a siacedi achub newydd ar gyfer yr 14 aelod o fad achub hanesyddol Charles Henry Ashley.

Cafodd **Blagur Haf Caergeiliog** £350 tuag at offer chwarae addysgol yn yr awyr agored. Bydd y plant bach yn elwa o ddau feic bach tair olwyn, gorsaf bwmpio, gwteri dŵr plastig a beic ag olwynion bach.

Gwelwyd **Cylch Chwarae Cyn Ysgol Amlwch, Cylch Meithrin Amlwch a Chylch Chwarae Benllech** i gyd yn elwa o gyfraniad tuag at offer addysgol hefyd.

Môn Actif Cafodd £1,000 er mwyn cynnal pedwar digwyddiad undydd wedi'u noddi gan Magnox mewn Canolfannau Hamdden ledled Ynys Môn. Byddant yn cynnig cyfleoedd pêl-droed, nofio, athletau, rygbi, pêl-rwyd, tennis ac amrywiaeth o gemau aml-chwaraeon. Bydd

yr arian yn helpu 25 o bobl ifanc i ennill Cymhwyster Lefel 2 Arweinwyr Chwaraeon Cymunedol.

Prynodd **Hyfforddiant Parys** ddeg cyfrifiadur bwrdd gwaith Windows 10 gyda £1,000 o'r cynllun. Rhagwelir y bydd hyn yn helpu gyda hyfforddiant ar gyfer dros 150 o unigolion sy'n defnyddio'r cyfleusterau.

Y prosiectau trawsnewid mawr a gefnogir:

Cafodd **Anglesey Column Trust** ei chreu i adfer Colofn y Marcwis sy'n rhestredig Gradd II*. Bydd y prosiect £966,000 yn adfer y golofn fel atyniad i dwristiaid ac yn ailfodelu'r bwthyn fel caffi a chanolfan addysg i ymwelwyr. Bydd y cyfraniad o £70,000 gan Magnox yn ariannu'r cynllun cyfieithu/dehongli dwyieithog. Nod y prosiect yw agor erbyn mis Medi 2021 a rhagwelir y bydd y caffi a'r ganolfan ymwelwyr yn arwain at greu deg o swyddi newydd, dros 40 o gyfleoedd gwirfoddoli a busnesau newydd. Bydd y prosiect yn ymgysylltu hefyd â 26 o ysgolion lleol, Prifysgol Bangor a Grŵp Llandrillo Menai sy'n cynnig rhaglenni addysgol.

Derbyniodd Menter Môn gyllid uniongyrchol gwerth £400,000 gan yr NDA dros ddwy flynedd ar gyfer Morlais B - cam nesaf y prosiect. Lansio Cronfa Adfywio Newydd Gogledd Ynys Môn

Mae Cronfa Adfywio newydd Gogledd Ynys Môn, a reolir gan Gyngor Sir Ynys Môn, wedi agor gan gynnig grantiau i helpu busnesau a chefnogi digwyddiadau lleol.



Fel rhan o'r £495,000 o gyllid a ymrwymwyd gan yr NDA, mae cronfa gyllido newydd ar gael sy'n werth £50,000 ar gyfer grantiau bach hyd at £5,000 i helpu busnesau a grwpiau cymunedol yn wardiau Talybolion a Thwrcelyn, ac yng nghymuned Moelfre (fel y nodir yng Nghynllun Adfywio Economaidd Gogledd Ynys Môn).

Bydd y gronfa'n darparu grantiau bach ar gyfer prosiectau addas sydd â'r nod o gefnogi twf economaidd, hybu'r Gymraeg, creu swyddi a gwella sgiliau, gweithio mewn partneriaeth, gwarchod yr amgylchedd a chreu cymunedau cynaliadwy.
