1 Welcome and Receive Apologies for Absence

The Chair welcomed all to the meeting at 9:30 am and apologies were noted as above. He welcomed Angharad Crump, Energy Island Programme Delivery Manager, Isle of Anglesey County Council and Cllr Jackie Lewis, newly elected Councillor for Talybolion Ward to their first meeting of the SSG. He noted that Cllr Derek Owen has also been recently elected as a County Councillor.

4 SSG Chairman's Report

The Chair provided a brief update on the following:

- Opening of the Magnox Wylfa Hub Office which was officially opened on 5.10.22. He was pleased to note that several young apprentices attended the opening and that this Hub will be a valuable modern resource for the future.
- Attended the NDA Summit on the 7-8 September 2022 in Edinburgh with the Vice Chair Derek Owen.

5 Wylfa Site Director's Report

Stuart Law presented his comprehensive report, copies of which had been circulated prior to the meeting. The report is summarised as follows:-

- Safety Statistics – no issues of safety concern reported
- Waste Projects –
 - HAW / LAW facility - contract with scheme design awarded to Atkins.
 - Construct a new skip compound - planning permission application submitted and ground investigation work completed.
 - DCIC storage facility - scheme design verification complete. Design Authority Review 2 - sign off was achieved 1st July 2022.
- Deaerator floor asbestos removal – Stuart Law noted that the project to remove or clean 18,819m² from the Deaerator floor to ensure it is asbestos free is going well. The work is being carried out by principal contractor, Altrad, which is the first time a contract of this type has been let at Wylfa site.

- Magnox Hub Wylfa - there are 68 workstations and four meeting rooms, each with video conference facilities and the capacity to seat from 4 to 60 people.
- NDA Group Employee Awards - two Wylfa teams reached the finals of the NDA Group Employee Awards 2022 which was acknowledged by members as a fantastic achievement for both teams.
- Magnox Recruitment
 - 1 ex-Orthios apprentice has been taken on to allow for continuation of the apprenticeship. 4 Magnox apprentices started in September.
 - 4 new permanent members of staff starting at Wylfa site.
 - Magnox support office staff working at the Magnox Wylfa Hub.
- Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics – Engagement by Wylfa and Trawsfynydd
 - The site has hosted school work experience individuals.
 - Working closely with STEM GweGogledd Cymru (GWE) supporting activities, events and promoting diversity in Magnox.
- Sustainability –transferred to other sites or sold on to the local community are:
 - BA Compressor sold to Amlwch Diving School.

- Fire engine and pumps transferred to Sellafield.
- Mobile fire pumps transferred to Dounreay.
- JCB transferred to Maentwrog.
- Visits - Michael Portillo visited Wylfa in August as a feature location in the next of his TV series called 'Great British Railway Journeys'.
- Swedish energy company UNIPER also visited the site to share de-commissioning experience.
- Magnox Socio-economics update
 - Môn Communities Forward (Môn CF) received £98,000 contribution from Magnox towards the £175,000 transformational project, creating a new multi-agency hub in the old Barclays Bank, Amlwch.
 - Anglesey Young Farmers received £1,500 from Magnox to purchase materials for various competitions in their Annual Rally, held for the first time in 2 years.

Members were then shown a video of recent Wylfa achievements which outlined the decommissioning journey to date and is also used to aid recruitment and as a guide for new starters.

The Chair thanked Mr Law for his report and sight of the video. Cllr GWR seconded the vote of thanks.

Question and Answer Session

None received; however, it was agreed to hold a site visit, hopefully scheduled prior to the September 2023 meeting of this group. **Action – Secretariat to liaise with the site to arrange.**

6 Magnox Corporate update

Mr Bill Hamilton Communications Director for Magnox was welcomed to the meeting. He gave a brief presentation on corporate issues summarised as follows:-

Regeneration

He stated that the organisation has an exciting future ahead as it doubles in scale and scope over the coming years. Its remit and mission is to be responsible for the safe and secure decommissioning of 12 nuclear sites and operation of one hydro-electric plant. To this end, Magnox has developed a Regeneration Programme.

The Future Missions team will be responsible for Magnox's strategy for integrating new decommissioning work scope into the existing portfolio. Two key aspects are Magnox joining with Dounreay under a single licensee board by April 2023 and transferring and decommissioning EDF's seven advanced gas-cooled reactor sites, post-defueling.

Communications

Magnox endeavours to engage closely with local communities and stakeholders around its sites via networks such as the SSGs, but to reach a wider audience it utilises a range of social media such as LinkedIn and Twitter. It is also currently exploring whether it can engage with younger audiences on TikTok and Instagram and has a YouTube channel that hosts a series of videos about Magnox work.

Earlier in the year Magnox ran an engagement survey with its employees, which highlighted areas of ongoing improvement that the company wanted to address. These included ensuring there were more opportunities to celebrate collective accomplishments and receive updated information about Magnox's forward-looking strategy.

Asbestos Removal

Our commitment to removing and remediating asbestos material from Magnox sites has continued this year, with significant project milestones already being hit.

The deaerator asbestos removal project at Wylfa is well over the half-way mark, and the project is making great strides into their 2022/23 target.

The Chair thanked BH for his update.

Question and Answer Session – none received, however, Cllr Derek Owen wished to thank Mair Jones and the team for the excellent work undertaken regarding the Socio-economic funding. Bill Hamilton noted that this funding is particularly beneficial to North Anglesey and that Magnox takes pride in supporting local communities.

7. Nuclear Decommissioning Authority

Mr Simon Napper was welcomed to the meeting and gave a brief summary of the report previously circulated to members as follows:-

NDA Working

NDA continues to operate on a hybrid working model with a mix of home-working and office-based work. Currently, personnel are working on an average of 2-3 days a week in the office.

NDA Business Plan

It is hoped to launch the business plan in December 2022 with an 8-week consultation period to follow.

Economic Impact Assessments

NDA has updated its assessments of the economic impact of its activities with three reports published (Dounreay, Cumbria and the Magnox sites) which are available on the NDA's website for perusal and SN noted that he was happy to respond to any resulting queries or questions from SSG members.

AGR Transfer

SN stated that all the fuel will be transferred to Sellafield for storage until a GDF has been identified. The cost of defuelling and decommissioning the seven AGR reactors is due to be met from the Nuclear Liabilities Fund.

Cwmni Eginio

The NDA and Cwmni Eginio announced in May 2022 that they would work together on proposals for the siting of a new nuclear development at Trawsfynydd in North Wales. With the agreement of BEIS, the two organisations have been working towards a collaboration agreement aimed at progressing plans which will ultimately support the UK government's Energy Security Strategy. This has been formalised in a Memorandum of Understanding which summarises how they will work together.

NDA Summit – 'Keep the Conversation Going'

Held in central Edinburgh on 7-8 September, nearly 170 people participated from across

the UK, which provided an opportunity to update on the new group structure and plans

The Chair thanked Simon Napper for his update and supported the work being undertaken to engage with young people.

Question and Answer session

Cllr GWR enquired as to the prospect of a Small Modular Reactor (SMR) being situated at Wylfa. SN noted that various options are currently under discussion.

8 Office for Nuclear Regulation Update

An ONR report was circulated with the meeting papers; however, Mr Ian Dallas was unable to attend the meeting. The content of the report was noted by the SSG members present.

9 Natural Resources Wales / Environmental Agency Update

A joint NRW/EA report was circulated with the meeting papers; however, Kate Simpson EA was unable to attend the meeting. The content of the report was noted by the SSG members present

10 Open Forum Question and Answer Session – none raised

11. Any Other Business

The Chair wished to thank Mr Ken Hughes and Mr John Griffiths for their contribution to the SSG in their capacity as Isle of Anglesey County Councillors. It was unanimously agreed to formally express the SSG's thanks and best wishes to them both.

He also wished to thank Mrs Jill Callander for her attendance and efficient meeting arrangements, wishing her a safe journey home to Ecclefechan in Scotland.

Foreword

This report is issued as part of ONR's commitment to make information about inspection and regulatory activities relating to the above site available to the public. Reports are distributed to members for the Wylfa Site Stakeholder Group (SSG) and are also available on the ONR website (<http://www.onr.org.uk/llc/>).

Site inspectors from ONR usually attend Wylfa SSG meetings where these reports are presented and will respond to any questions raised there. Any person wishing to inquire about matters covered by this report should contact ONR.

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1. Inspections

1.1. Dates of Inspection

ONR Inspectors made inspections on the following dates during the report period 1 July 2022 to 31 December 2022:

- 23 August 2022
- 21 to 22 September 2022
- 17 November 2022
- 21 November 2022

2. Routine Matters

2.1. Inspections

Inspections are undertaken as part of the process for monitoring compliance with:

- the conditions attached by ONR to the nuclear site licence granted under the Nuclear Installations Act 1965 (NIA65) (as amended);
- the Energy Act 2013;
- the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 (HSWA74);
- regulations made under HSWA74, for example the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017 (IRR17) and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 (MHSWR99);
- Nuclear Industries Security Regulations (NISR) 2003 (as amended); and
- Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.

The inspections entail monitoring licensee's actions on the site in relation to incidents, operations, maintenance, projects, modifications, safety case changes and any other matters that may affect safety and security. The licensee is required to make and implement adequate arrangements under the conditions attached to the licence in order to ensure legal compliance. Inspections seek to judge both the adequacy of these arrangements and their implementation.

In this period, routine inspections of Wylfa covered the following:

- incidents on the site;
- management of operations including control and supervision;
- waste management (radioactive and controlled waste);
- decommissioning;
- conventional (non-nuclear) health and safety; and
- security.

Our waste management inspection carried out in September 2022 was conducted jointly with Natural Resources Wales (supported by the Environment Agency).

An inspection of Wylfa's emergency arrangements planned for 20 September 2022 was postponed until January 2023 due to the state funeral for Her Majesty the Queen taking place on Monday 19th September, and the impact this had on availability of emergency services and other personnel.

2.2. Other Work

Throughout this reporting period, ONR's nominated site safety inspector has held fortnightly meetings with a Wylfa leadership team representative to maintain situational awareness on matters related to nuclear safety, security, safeguards, transport, and conventional health and safety. This includes: workforce resilience, emergency arrangements resilience, supply chain resilience, fire safety, events on the site and activities taking place on the site.

ONR undertook a routine engagement the purpose of which was to discuss Wylfa's planned turbine hall demolition, including isolating services, and the provision of the site's future power requirements.

3. Non-Routine Matters

Licensees are required to have arrangements to respond to non-routine matters and events. ONR inspectors judge the adequacy of the licensee's response, including actions taken to implement any necessary improvements.

In accordance with its written arrangements, on 29 November 2022 Wylfa advised ONR that a fire had occurred during planned dismantling of a redundant transformer. The transformer had been stored at the north end of the site for several years and was not in a radiological controlled area. ONR was satisfied that Wylfa's response to this event was adequate and is now awaiting the outcome of the site's investigation before determining any regulatory follow up actions.

4. Regulatory Activity

ONR may issue formal documents to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements. Under nuclear site licence conditions, ONR issues regulatory documents, which either permit an activity or require some form of action to be taken; these are usually collectively termed 'Licence Instruments' (LIs) but can take other forms. In addition, inspectors may take a range of enforcement actions, to include issuing an Enforcement Notice.

No LIs, Enforcement Notices or Enforcement letters were issued during this period.

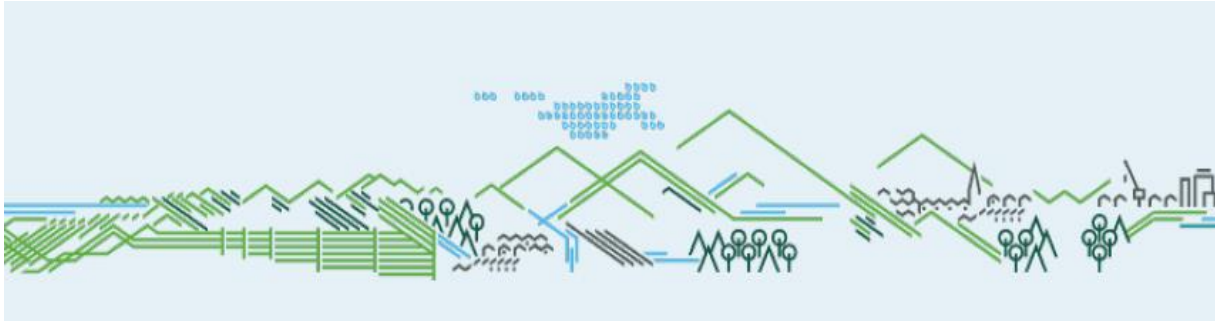

Mae trefn gytundebol ar waith sy'n galluogi Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru i ddefnyddio profiad ac adnoddau Grŵp Rheoleiddio Niwclear arbenigol Asiantaeth yr Amgylchedd i gynorthwyo wrth gyflawni gwaith arolygu ar y safle ac asesiadau cysylltiedig.

Rydym yn rheoleiddio'r trefniadau ar gyfer cael gwared ar wastraff ymbelydrol, gweithrediad y gwaith hylosgi, gollyngiadau i ddŵr, a gwastraff confensiynol. Gweler Atodiad 1 am ragor o wybodaeth am ein swyddogaeth.



Cyflwyniad

Mae'r adroddiad hwn yn ymdrin â'r cyfnod rhwng Medi 2022 ac Ebrill 2023.

Archwiliadau

Gwnaethom gynnal archwiliad ar y cyd ag ONR ym mis Hydref 2022 ar reoli gwastraff, gan gynnwys gwastraff ymbelydrol a di-ymbelydrol. Edrychwyd ar ddigwyddiadau sy'n gysylltiedig â gwastraff; lleihau a cronni gwastraff a goruchwyliaeth contractwyr ar gyfer rheoli gwastraff nad ydynt yn ymbelydrol.

Ni chofnodwyd unrhyw gamau peidio â chydymffurfio, ond ailadroddwyd dau argymhelliad gan arolygiad blaenorol i Magnox Cyf ystyried cynnwys rhanddeiliaid yn gynnar yn y gwaith o ddatblygu cyflwr pen y safle a sicrhau bod cynllun credadwy ar gyfer datblygu Cynllun Rheoli Gwastraff ac Achos Diogelwch Amgylcheddol Safle Eang ar gyfer Wylfa.

Ym mis Rhagfyr 2022, gwnaethom adolygu'r Achos Rheoli Gwastraff Ymbelydrol (RWMC) diweddaraf ar gyfer Wylfa ac ar y cyd ag ONR bu'n trafod y pynciau RWMC ar cysylltiadau gyda Gwastraff Gweithgaredd Uwch (HAW) safle Wylfa. Ni chafodd unrhyw ddiffyg cydymffurfiaeth ei chofnodi. Gwnaethom argymhellion ar sut y gallai Wylfa wella rheolaeth or Gwastraff Gweithgaredd Uwch (HAW) er mwyn galluogi cydymffurfio yn y dyfodol a gwella'r broses o ddiogelu'r amgylchedd.

Gollyngiadau

Roedd gollyngiadau ymbelydrol i aer a dŵr o Wylfa o fewn terfynau a ganiateir yn y cyfnod adrodd hwn. Roedd gollyngiadau nad ydynt yn ymbelydrol i ddŵr hefyd o fewn terfynau a ganiateir.

Cawsom wybod gan Wylfa ym mis Hydref 2022 am gamgymeriad wrth gyfrifo gollyngiadau nwyol o H-3 ac S-35 a oedd yn parhau o 2002 tan 2022. Er i'r camgymeriad arwain at danamcangyfrif gollyngiadau nwydus o H-3 a S-35, mae cyfrifiadau'n dangos na chafodd unrhyw derfynau trwydded eu rhagori.

Monitro amgylcheddol

Cawsom ganlyniadau'r rhaglen fonitro amgylcheddol yn ôl anghenion y drwydded gweithgareddau sylweddau ymbelydrol. Roedd canlyniadau'r rhaglen fonitro amgylcheddol fel arfer o fewn yr ystod arferol, ond roedd un canlyniad i Cs-137 mewn sampl o bridd yn fwy na'r cymedr ynghyd â 4 gwriad safonol o'r 12 canlyniad blaenorol.

Trwyddedu

Nid ydym wedi amrywio unrhyw drwyddedau amgylchedd yn ystod y cyfnod adrodd hwn.

Digwyddiadau a gwaith gorfodi

Rydym yn adolygu crynodeb o'r digwyddiadau rheolaidd ac yn trafod y rhai sy'n berthnasol i gydymffurfio amgylcheddol gyda Magnox Ltd fel rhan o'n rheoliad arferol.

Daethom i'r casgliad bod tanamcangyfrif gollyngiadau nwydus H-3 a S-35 (a ddisgrifir yn adran Gollyngiadau yr adroddiad hwn), yn cynrychioli diffyg cydymffurfio ag

amodau drwydd sy'n gofyn am ddefnyddio'r technegau sydd ar gael orau i gyfrifo gollyngiadau ac i weithredu gan ddefnyddio pobl ac adnoddau cymwys digonol. Ystyriwyd effaith rhesymol rhagweladwy y digwyddiad a'r achos sylfaenol fel mân a dosbarthwyd y ddau ddiffyg cydymffurfiaeth fel Categori 3 yn ein system dosbarthiad cydymffurfio (sy'n cynrychioli mân effaith amgylcheddol). Fodd bynnag, nid yw tan-adrodd gollyngiadau yn dderbyniol ac fe barhaodd y gwall cyfrifo am tua 20 mlynedd, felly fe wnaethom gyhoeddi llythyr rhybudd i Magnox Ltd.

Cawsom wybod gan Magnox Ltd. ym mis Hydref 2022 am gamgymeriad yr oedden nhw wedi'i nodi mewn taenlen ar gyfer cyfrifo ymbelydredd mewn gwastraff ymbelydrol metelaidd solet. Cafodd y camgymeriad ei ddarganfod cyn anfon unrhyw lwythi gwastraff ac fe ddaethon ni i'r casgliad nad oedd unrhyw achosion o beidio cydymffurfio â'r drwydded

Nid ydym wedi cymryd unrhyw gamau gorfodi yn erbyn Magnox Ltd. yn Wylfa yn y cyfnod adrodd hwn.

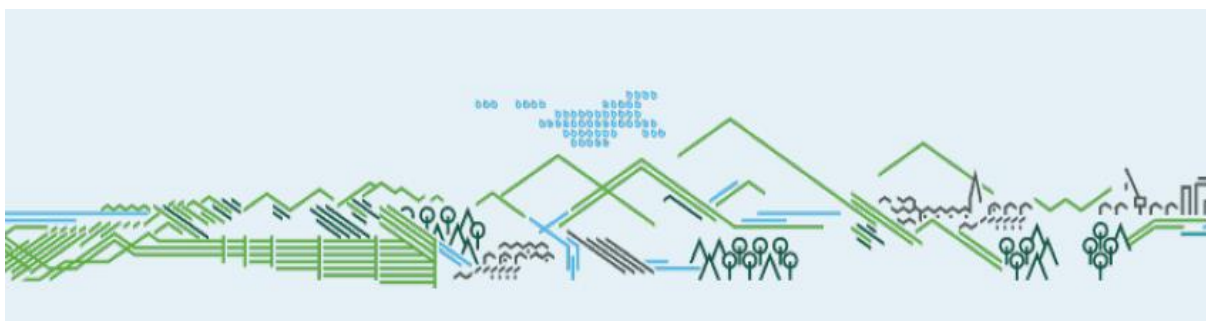

FOREWORD

This report is issued to the Site Stakeholder Group (SSG) to provide a brief summary of the regulatory activities of Natural Resources Wales (NRW) relating to the Wylfa nuclear site.

NRW is accountable to the Welsh Government for the environmental regulation of nuclear sites in Wales. NRW has a contractual arrangement in place which enables them to draw on the experience and resources of the Environment Agency's specialist Nuclear Regulation Group, to assist in the delivery of on-site inspection work and associated assessments.

We regulate the disposal of radioactive waste, operation of combustion plant, discharges to water and conventional waste. Please see Annex 1 for further information on our role.



Introduction

This report covers the period from September 2022 to March 2023.

Inspections

We carried out a joint inspection with ONR in October 2022 on waste management, including both radioactive and non-radioactive waste. We looked at waste-related events; waste minimisation and accumulation; and contractor oversight for non-radioactive waste management.

No non-compliances were recorded, but we repeated two recommendations from a previous inspection for Magnox Ltd to consider involving stakeholders early in the development of the site end state and ensure there is a credible plan to develop the Waste Management Plan and Site-Wide Environmental Safety Case for Wylfa.

In December 2022 we reviewed the latest Radioactive Waste Management Case (RWMC) for Wylfa and in conjunction with ONR discussed the RWMC and related Higher Activity Waste (HAW) topics with Wylfa. No non-compliances were recorded. We made recommendations on how Wylfa could improve the management of HAW to enable future compliance and enhance protection of the environment.

Discharges

Radioactive discharges to air and water from Wylfa were within permitted limits in this reporting period. Non-radioactive discharges to water were also within permitted limits.

We were notified by Wylfa in October 2022 of a mistake in the calculation of gaseous discharges of H-3 and S-35 that was ongoing from 2002 until 2022. Although the mistake led to underestimation of gaseous discharges of H-3 and S-35, calculations show that no permit limits were exceeded.

Environmental monitoring

We received the environmental monitoring programme results as required by the radioactive substances activities permit. The environmental monitoring programme results were typically within the normal range, however there was one result for Cs-137 in silt that exceeded the mean plus 4 standard deviations of the previous 12 results.

Permitting

We have not varied any environmental permits during this reporting period.

Events and enforcement

We regularly review summaries of all events reported and discuss those relevant to environmental compliance with Magnox Ltd as part of our routine regulation.

We concluded that the underestimation of gaseous discharges of H-3 and S-35 (described in the Discharges section of this report), represents non-compliance with permit conditions that require the use of best available techniques to calculate discharges and to operate using sufficient competent people and resources. The reasonably foreseeable impact of the event and the root cause were considered as minor and both non-compliances were classed as Category 3 in our compliance classification system (which represents a minor environmental impact). However,

under-reporting of discharges is not acceptable, and the calculation error persisted for approximately 20 years, therefore we also issued a warning letter to Magnox Ltd.

We were told by Magnox Ltd. in October 2022 about an error they had identified in a spreadsheet for calculating radioactivity in solid metallic radioactive waste. The error was discovered before any waste consignments were sent and we concluded that there were no non-compliances with the permit.

We have not taken any enforcement action against Magnox Ltd. at Wylfa in this reporting period.

Annex 1: The role of Natural Resources Wales and the Environment Agency at nuclear sites

Operating and cleaning up nuclear sites generates radioactive and non-radioactive wastes. Our role as the environmental regulator is to ensure that the impact of those wastes on people and the environment, now and in the future, is as small as it can be. We also aim to prevent pollution, enhance the environment, and contribute to the sustainable development of the UK.

We inspect nuclear sites and assess proposals from operators, to provide assurance that the operator is complying with the limits and conditions of the permits we issue under the Environmental Permitting Regulations 2016 (as amended) and other relevant legislation and policy.

We supplement direct regulation with a partnership approach, working with the operators, the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA) and the Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR) to solve problems jointly.

We expect operators to comply fully with all relevant legislative requirements and permits. If this does not happen, we will not hesitate to use our enforcement powers to ensure that action is taken to protect the environment or to secure compliance.

In summary our objectives are to:

- Ensure that environmental permits are up to date, flexible and fit for purpose and that they drive environmental improvement
- Assess compliance with the limits and conditions of the permits
- Reduce risks to the environment and avoid creating further legacies
- Ensure that integrated waste strategies continue to improve
- Ensure that solid waste is packaged in a form suitable for disposal
- Ensure that infrastructure and assets are maintained to minimise environmental impact
- Develop guidance on Best Available Techniques (BAT)
- Influence NDA so that they provide appropriate direction to operators to minimise waste and improve environmental outcomes
- Encourage integrated management of fuel and nuclear materials so as to prevent or minimise the potential environmental impacts
- Ensure land and groundwater contaminated by radioactivity or other pollutants is managed appropriately and protect land and groundwater from further contamination
- Monitor and assess organisational change to ensure that environmental performance is maintained

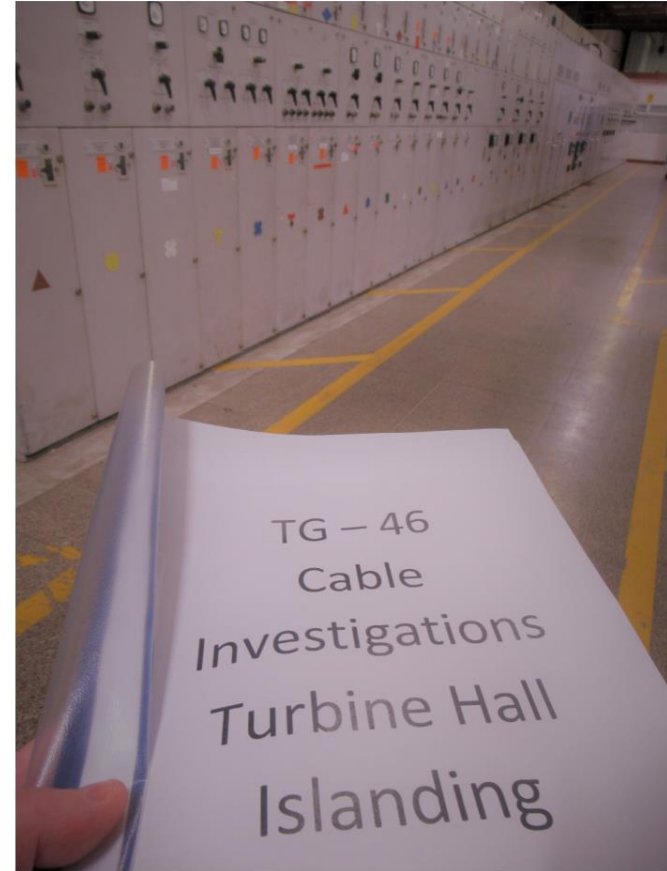

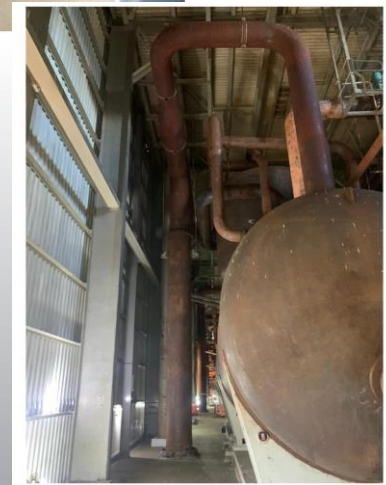

Anglesey Column Trust received £70,000 Magnox funding in 2019 towards a £1.3m project to refurbish and reopen the historic Marquess of Anglesey column. The cottage will also be transformed into a heritage centre, containing bilingual interpretation boards and a café.

Having now secured all match funding, including over £872,000 National Heritage Lottery funding, Magnox funding has been released and construction work commenced in November 2022.

The official opening is expected in March 2024.

NDA Update

UK Government

- Whole team of civil servants concerned with nuclear in BEIS have moved into the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero (DESNZ)
- Secretary of State is Grant Shapps, who was SoS at BEIS
- New minister for nuclear has been announced. He is Andrew Bowie who has been appointed Minister for Nuclear and Networks.
- Perm Secs Clive Maxwell (previously in BEIS) and Jeremy Pocklington (previously DCMS but before that DECC)

NDA Update

Stakeholder Survey

- NDA commissions an independent organisation to survey stakeholders every two years
- 800 people took part, 200 more than the last survey. Mix of key stakeholders and those on our mailing list to receive updates electronically.
- Key indicators all up since last time – trust, transparency and openness.
- We also asked people where we could improve: one of the key findings was that they wanted to know more about mission delivery and how we solve technical challenges, so we will address that.

NDA Update

Stakeholder Summit

- After the event in Edinburgh last September, NDA has decided that the next in-person Stakeholder Summit will be held in Cumbria in 2024.
- There will be an online, virtual Summit this year in the autumn.
- During the year, though, we will be holding a series of in-person, regional meetings for stakeholders. It is planned these will be linked to universities with a nuclear science department, so that we can showcase the links between NDA, research and innovation.
- The first two will be in Cumbria and Scotland in June. More details as soon as we have them.

NDA Update

NIA Week in Parliament

- The Nuclear Industry Association annually organises a series of events to draw the sector to MPs' attention.
- NDA sponsored a reception for Parliamentarians highlighting the decommissioning aspects of nuclear.
- NDA sponsored the Skills Fair and brought graduates and apprentices to London for them to meet their local MP – and for the MPs to understand the work of the NDA in their communities.



NDA Update

NDA and new nuclear

- Great British Nuclear has been launched. It will initially focus on Small Modular Reactors.
- Magnox Chief Executive Gwen Parry-Jones will be the first Chief Executive of GBN. She starts this interim role on 1 May.
- Prior to GBN, NDA had been approached by a number of developers and technology providers asking about the availability of land on our sites. We have provided publicly available information on an open and transparent basis to enquirers.
- We are continuing to support Cwmni Eginio in Wales, in line with the Memorandum of Understanding agreed with Government.

NDA Update

Decommissioning and waste management consultation

- Government consultation on decommissioning and waste management has been published. This updates, consolidates and introduces new options.
- Has been agreed by BEIS, Scottish Government and Welsh Government. The 1995 paper was issued before devolution: waste management, though, is a devolved responsibility. This paper aligns policy to current situation.
- This is a full 12-week consultation, closing on 24 May. Engagement is being led by Government. Requests for meetings about the consultation can be made by email to: RSNDPolConsult@beis.gov.uk

NDA Graduate Scheme

- The challenge of ensuring NDA and its operating companies have sufficient highly-skilled and motivated personnel over several generations as it fulfils its mission is one of its priorities.
- In January it launched a new group-wide graduate programme to help ensure a continued flow of young people into the business.
- Applications are now open for roles in around 20 different professional disciplines at various locations in all corners of Britain.
- The new programme, supported by NDA subsidiary Energus, will offer three placements in different parts of the group. It will operate alongside the graduate schemes run by other operating companies.

NDA Update

Concrete box

- As an alternative to the established steel boxes, the first concrete to be filled with radioactive waste has now been transferred into the purpose-built waste store at Berkeley site.
- The project involved the development of a brand new waste storage package and innovative waste retrieval techniques.



NDA Update

Robots in a radioactive environment

- A robot designed with help from Dounreay to safely inspect hazardous environments is in Time Magazine's top 200 innovations of 2022.
- The robot, known as Lyra, has been used to inspect ventilation ducts and feedback radiological information. Human access to this area is currently impossible due to the size of the duct and radiological risks.



NDA Update

Working together to find a solution

- As an example of how different parts of OneNDA are collaborating with one another, Sellafield and Nuclear Waste Services have developed a solution to a radioactive waste problem.
- Sellafield has contaminated chemical waste in stores on site. There was no compliant way to move these to other locations. Working with NWS, an existing waste drum was redesigned with inner linings of plastic, metal, or glass. These enable the chemicals to be transferred to other stores on site.
- For Sellafield, this means greater efficiencies – they are able to pack more into the containers, and the approach will significantly reduce the time it will take for them to safely store these chemicals.
