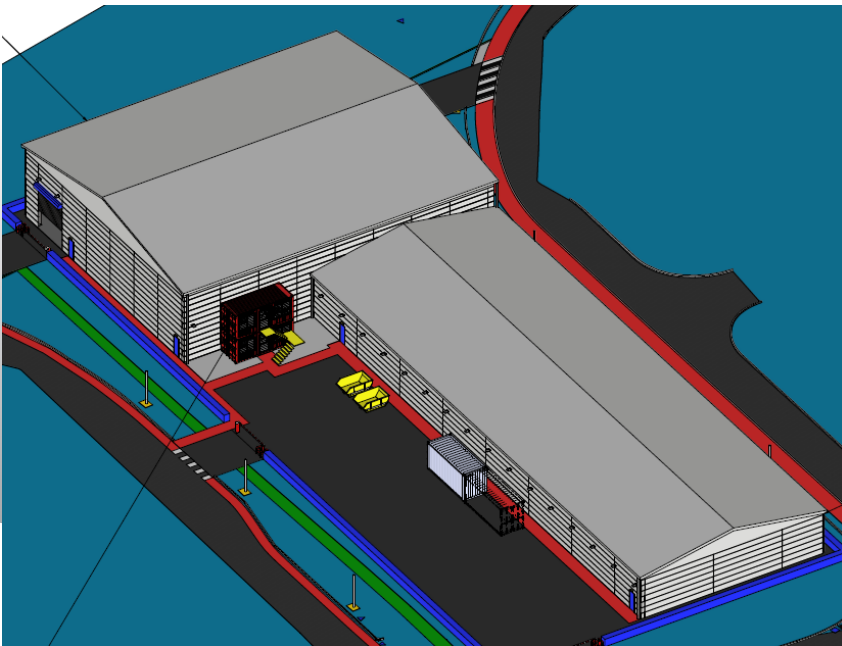
Waste Retrievals Update

- Retrievals have continued after a successful ~1 month planned outage. Retrievals so far this financial year are ~13 tonnes against a target of 46.7 tonnes for the year
- Retrievals in the Shielded Area are progressing with the first MOSAIK DCIC being filled and the second one now being filled
- One LLW shipment has also been completed so far this financial year.



Blower House Project

- **Contract 1 - Blower House emptying, remediation and demolition.** Altrad have a small team at site and are progressing with documentation and arranging various site visits for their sub-contractors
- **Contract 2 - Metallic waste management.** Nuclear Waste Services and their contractors Augean and NSG have been progressing the temporary waste compound design. A planning application has been now been submitted to Gloucester County Council for the new building.

Site activities – Turbine Hall isolation

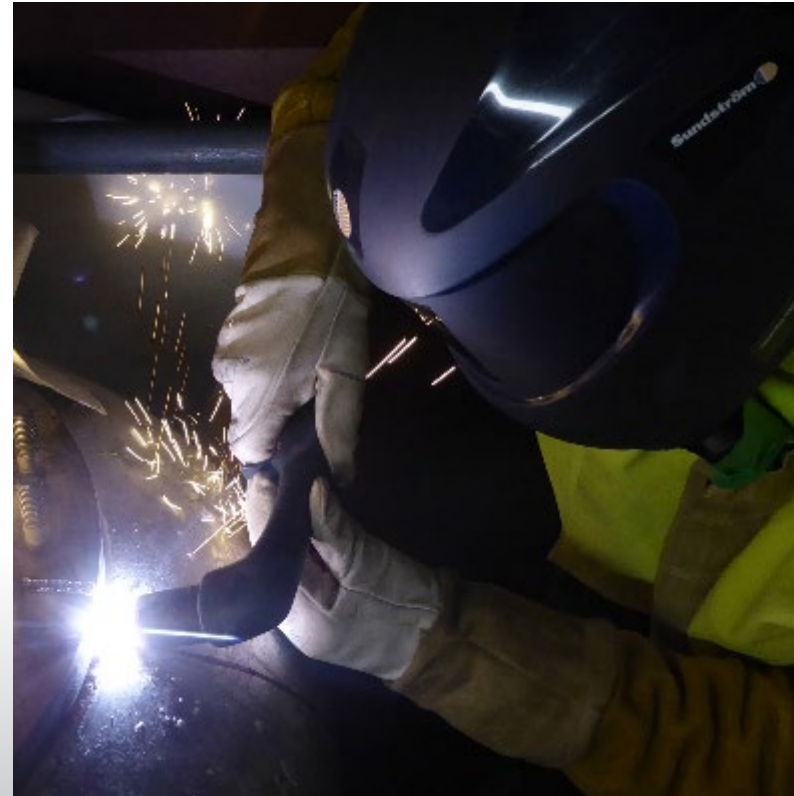


- Total of 303 out of 1914 cables cut to date

- Magnox Soc-ec Funding remains at £1,020,035 with £302,958 multi year funding already committed

Berkeley applications 2023-24:

- **Frampton-on-Severn Cricket Club £915** – Youth team cricket kit
- **Dr Jenner Museum Trust £587** – purchase of light-meter
(Note: £3,938 GN allocation for Berkeley remaining out of nominal £6,000 allocation)
- **Hill Village Hall £560** – purchase of trestle tables
- **Hinton Parish Council £5,000** – towards inclusive roundabout in new redeveloped playpark
- **Dursley Rugby Club - £10,000** – towards solar panels to support aim of being carbon neutral by 2030 as part of a larger project to improve energy efficiency and climate impact at the club.



Oldbury applications 2023-24:

- **Friends of Manorbrook School £1,303** – purchase of replacement of Adventure Playground equipment (Traversing Forest – 7 posts)
- **Oldbury-on-Severn Parish Council £1,400** –purchase of ‘Lest We Forget’ bench
(Note: £3,297 GN allocation for Oldbury remaining out of nominal £6,000 allocation).
- **Envision Community Apprentice - £30,000** – year 3 of 3 to support disadvantage teenagers, across five schools, to reach their potential and inspire them to aspire to be whatever they want to be (supported by mentors from Magnox working with Brimsham Green School and other companies doing the same with the other four schools).
