

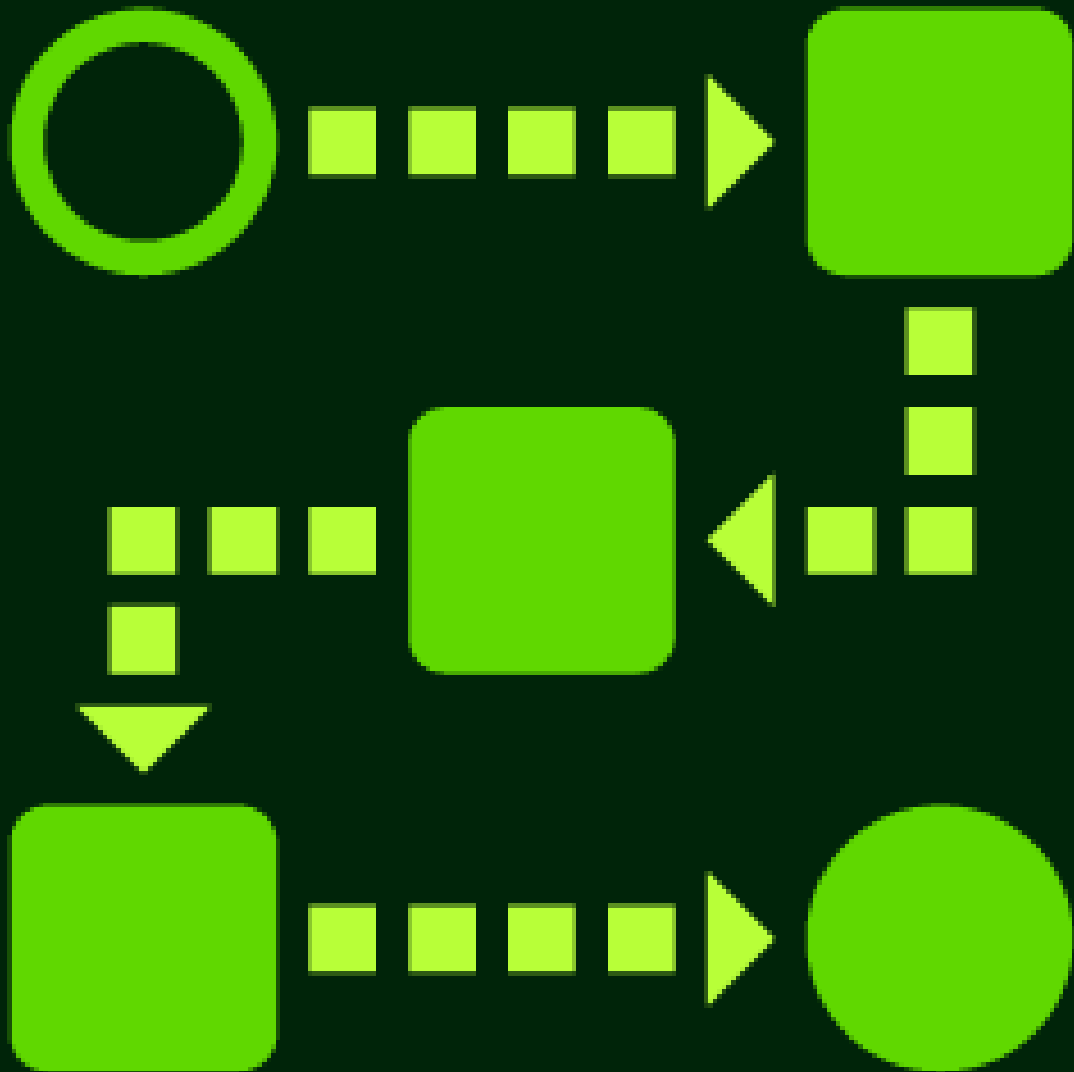

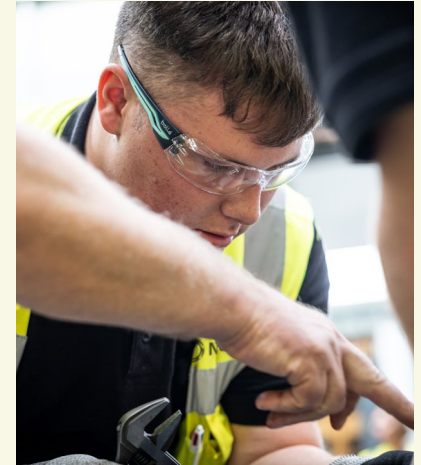
- 'Hinkley A School' continuing to invest in existing staff and local community to address local and national skills shortages

Demin Tank - Update

Event date - 31st August 2023

Main Demin water tank for the site within the RCA was 'out of spec'. The tank was drained after samples were taken of the water showing no radioactivity. Upon discharging this water to the storm drains, analysis of the remaining layer of sludge showed it to be radioactive. An RCI was initiated at this point followed by an EA inspection.

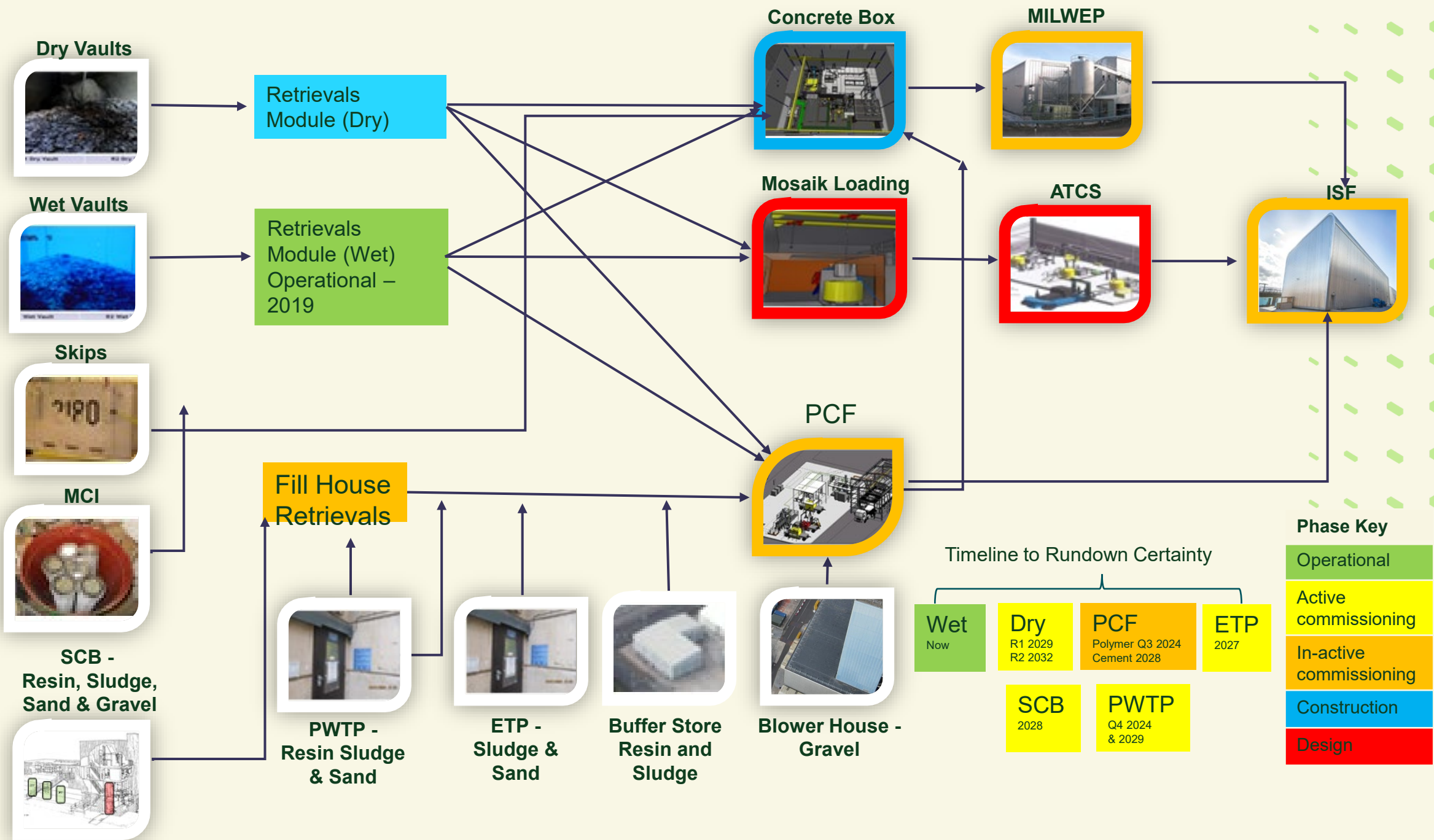

Hinkley A Intermediate Level Waste Journey



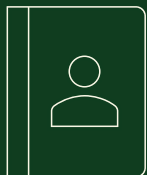

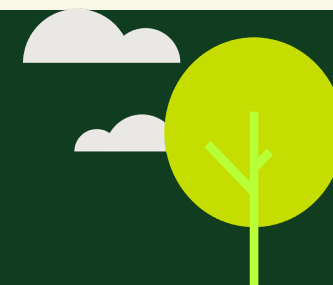
