Safety and Environmental Performance

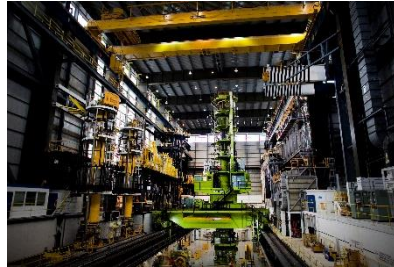
- ❑ Over **18** years since our last nuclear reportable event – world class performance
- ❑ **1** lost time incident (LTI)
- ❑ **5** first aid injuries since the last SSG meeting (all of a minor nature)
- ❑ **1** top tier environmental reportable event in **14** years
- ❑ Held a successful Safety Day earlier this month
- ❑ Lloyds Register Quality Assurance (LRQA) recertification
- ❑ Successfully exited COMAH Regulations due to reduction in hazards
- ❑ Held 'Pride in the Point' day



Defueling Progress

Latest position

- ❑ Reactor 4 declared 'fuel free' on August 9, 2024
- ❑ removed 43 (14%) irradiated fuel assemblies out of a total of 308 from reactor 3
- ❑ dispatched over 200 spent fuel flasks to Sellafield since defueling started in September 2022



Transition and Decommissioning

- ❑ Collaborative work with NRS is continuing as we look forward to transferring the Hinkley Point B site in 2026
- ❑ We finished our second public consultation on the decommissioning of Hinkley Point B in late Spring 2024. Our Nuclear Reactor (Environmental Impact Assessment for Decommissioning) Regulations consent application was submitted to ONR on 30 August
- ❑ A Decommissioning Waste Processing Facility is required for processing low level waste during decommissioning activities. A joint NRS / EDF Working Group has been setup to oversee proposals
- ❑ Work to review initial options for managing our future Active Effluent Discharge is underway



NRS Engagement Day

On Monday 14 October we held the first of a series of 'Engagement Days', where our NRS colleagues visited and spoke to staff about what it feels like to work for NRS, how decommissioning looks in practice, and the wider contextual background about the company and the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA).

We also heard from a number of our A station colleagues about their own personal career journeys within the NRS group.
