Decommissioning Projects

- Pond trench de-plant largely complete.
- 1900 of 2130 Turbine Hall cable cuts complete.
- Commercial activities underway for OTC demolition.



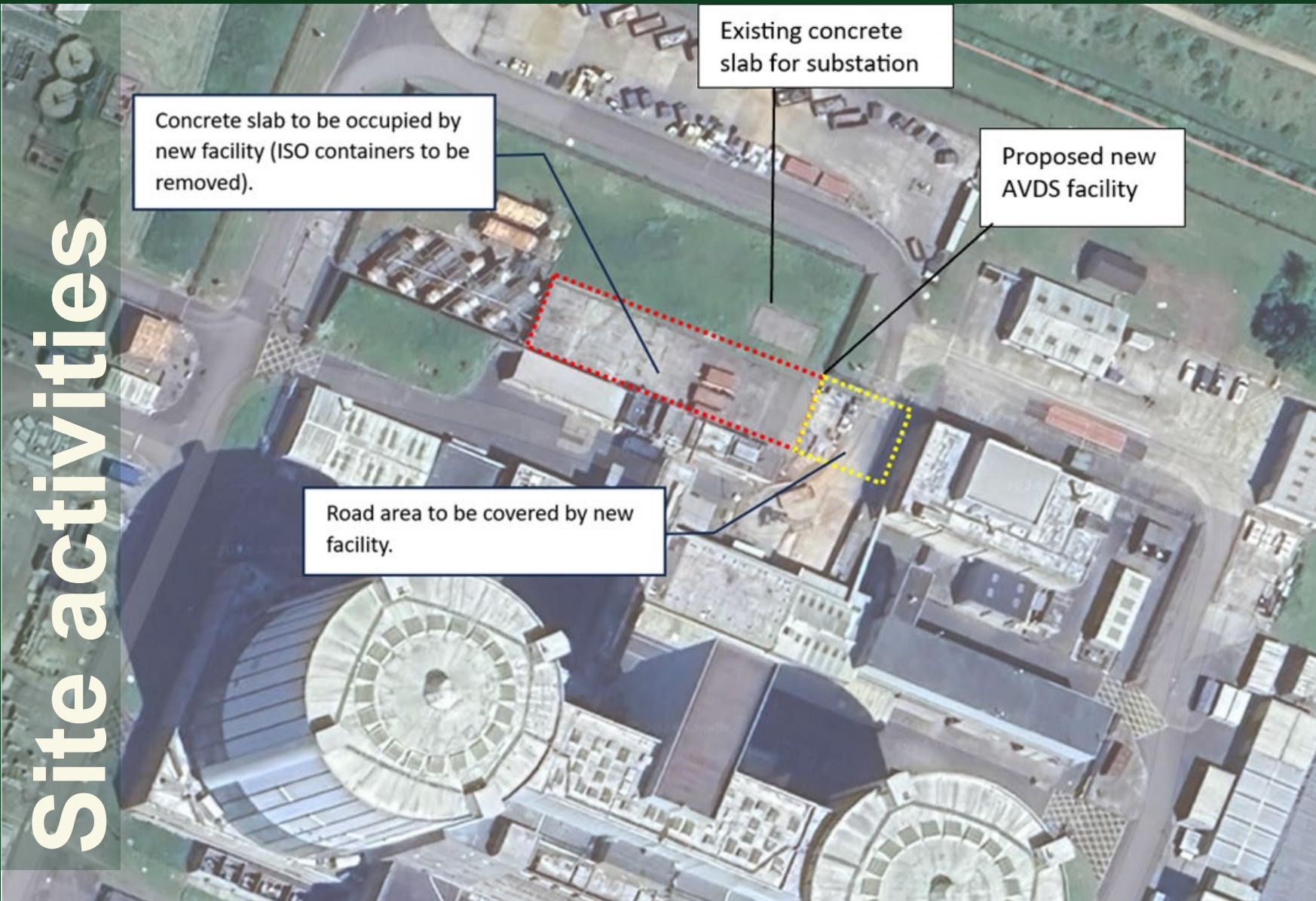
Waste Projects – Wet Waste Retrieval

Progress with Vacuum Fill House has focused on installation of the valves, hoses and cables into the buildings from where waste will be retrieved.

Mechanical installation is now complete and setting to work and site acceptance activities have now commenced.



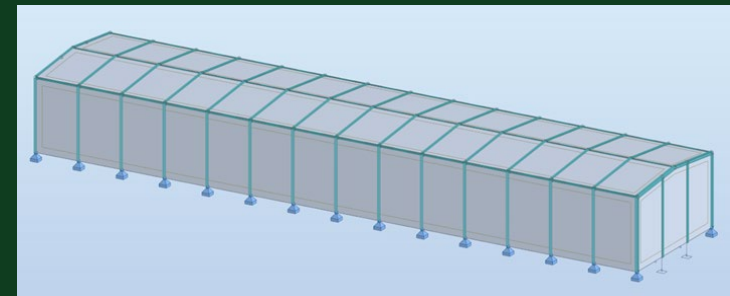
Waste Projects – New Drying Facility



Site activities

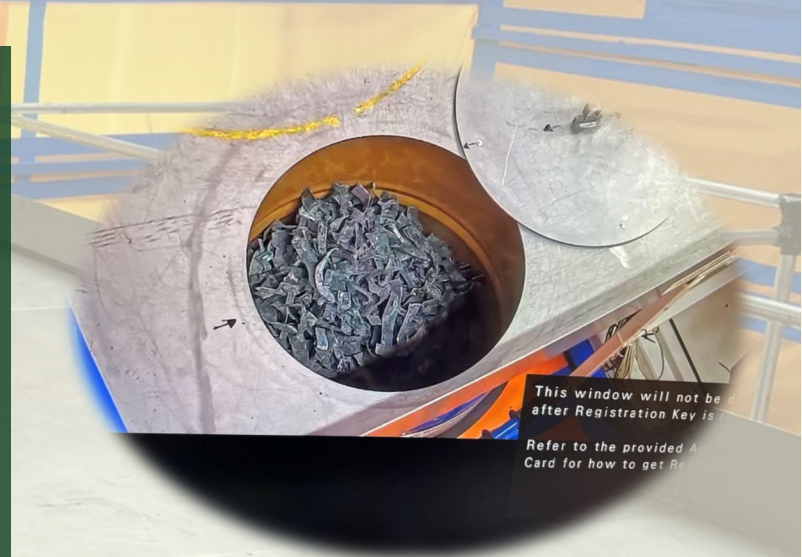
Advanced Vacuum Drying System (AVDS) design is progressing, enabling a tender to be issued for the building.

Preparation for the planning application is also in progress. Planned construction is due to start on site is mid 2025.



Waste Projects – Early Fuel Element Debris (FED)

- Trial of FED waste retrieval and sorting into drums.
- Installation of bespoke equipment and inactive commissioning are now complete.
- Project now operational.

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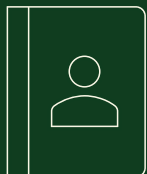

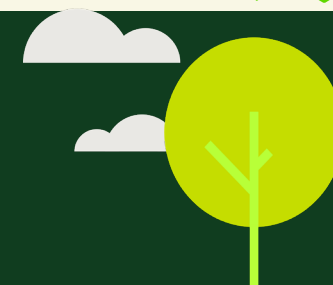

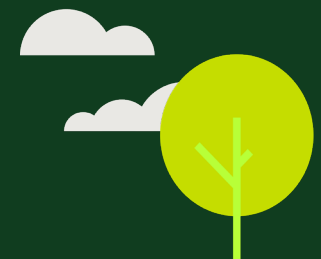
