- Collaborative working with Sizewell B & C - driving consistent standards and expectations of our personnel to support safe, secure and complaint delivery

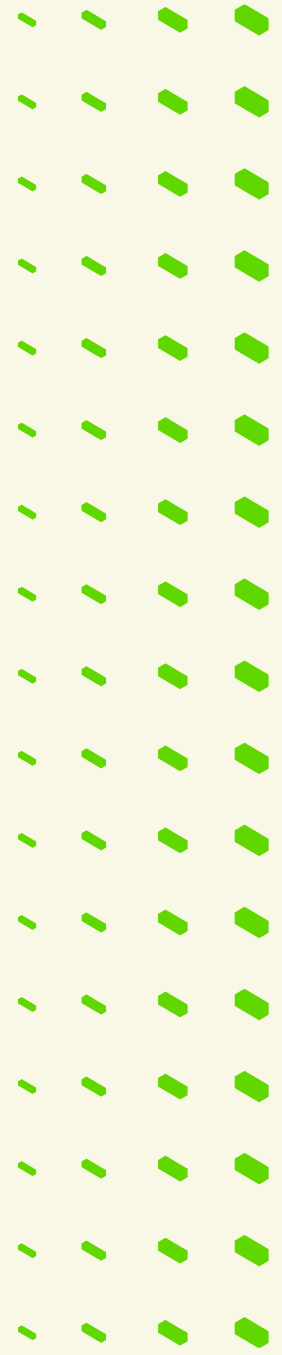
Sizewell Sustainability Group

Sustainability activities completed:

- The Sustainability action group has gathered momentum and is supported by Staff from different functions and Contractor partners. Bi-monthly meetings have already identified areas for action and initiatives to support the local community
- The Site held a 'Wear It Pink Day' raising awareness of Breast Cancer and in support of Cancer Charity Breast Cancer Now. The Site raised £612 through bake sales and donations that will help the charity provide support to those affected by cancer
- Acknowledging that this time of year can be particularly difficult for some families, NRS Sizewell A has reinstated the food bank donation initiative that was so successful last year. Donations went to the Leiston Food Bank at the United Church.

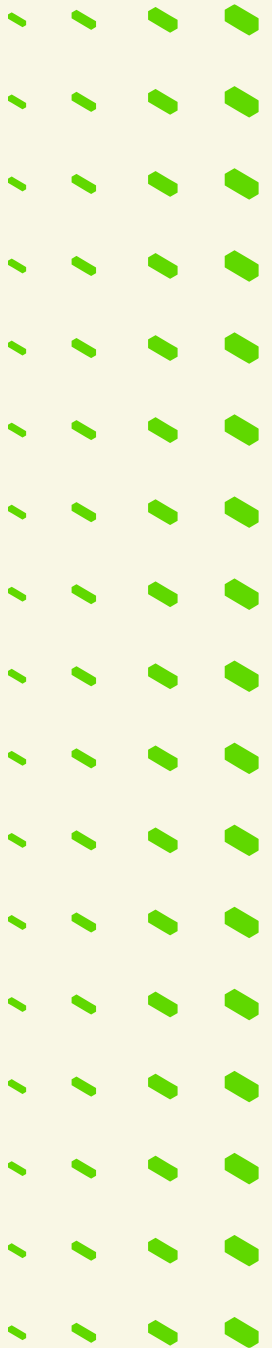
- Installation of a new fence atop the existing Ha-Ha Wall on the southern boundary of site.

Recruitment - Apprentices

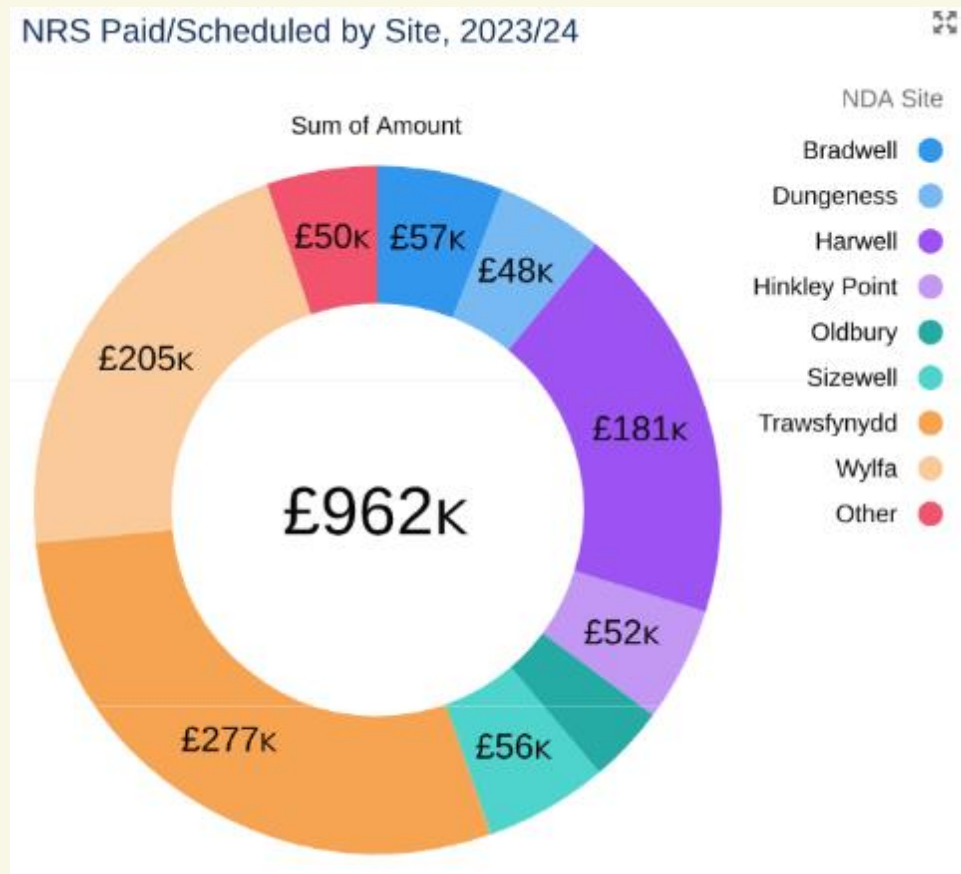

Socio Economic 2023-24

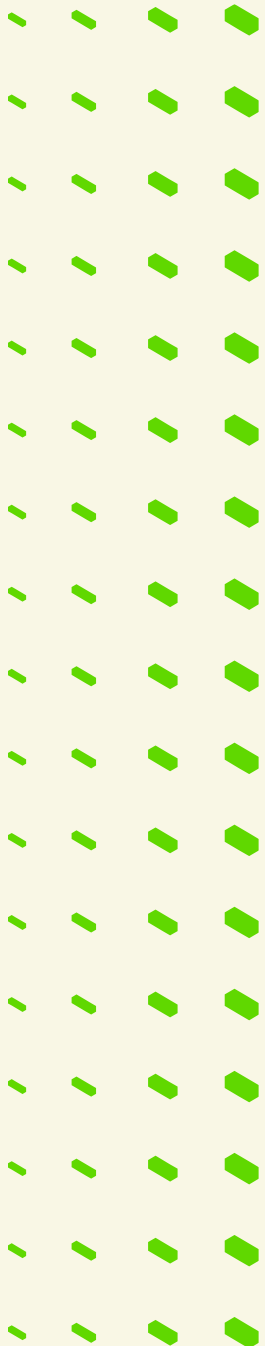
- Nuclear Restoration Services Socio-economic funding remains at £1,020,035 with £302,958 multi-year funding already committed.
- **Good Neighbour funding £2,000** per application; however, £6,000 allocation per site remains unchanged

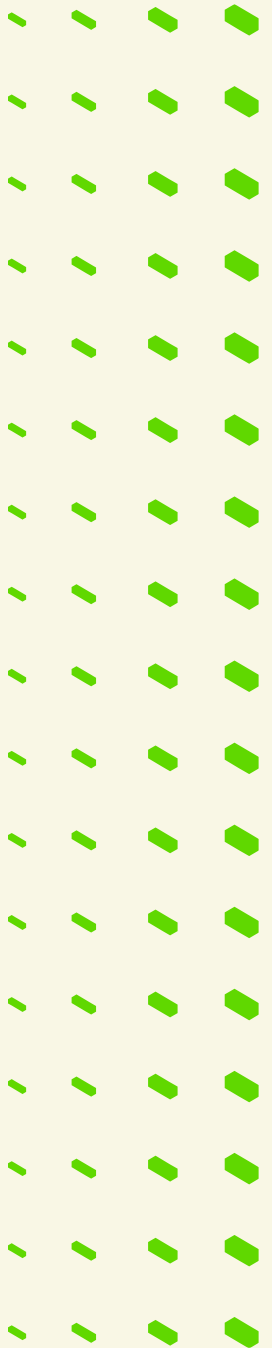

Sizewell applications 2023-24: £56,020

- Leiston Primary School £1,120 towards the purchase of two replacement interactive whiteboards
- Kesgrave Kestrels £1,000 towards new kit for U16's team
- Saxmundham Art Station £22,500 revenue funding for work placement and internships and towards Local Cultural Education Partnership (LCEP) Coordinator (£90,000 over three years)
- Leiston Long Shop Museum (£82,200 over three years) to employ a Community and Learning Officer and materials to enable projects to take place. £31,400 year one.

NDA Socio-economic Strategy Refresh 2023-24

- Under the Energy Act (2004), the NDA has a socio-economic role which recognises the importance of delivering the decommissioning programme in a socially responsible way. The approach to this is explained in the NDA Local Social and Economic Impact Strategy which was last published in July 2020.
- Over the last few months, the NDA has been engaging with stakeholders across the UK to better understand the social and economic priorities in our communities to identify priority areas of focus, to align our internal processes and systems, and to make best use of the funding available across the group for maximum community benefit.
- A new draft strategy has been developed and is undergoing a period of public consultation. This is ongoing and **closes on 21 February 2024** before comments are incorporated where possible, finalised and published.
