A native of his beloved Trawsfynydd he knew the area well and took great pride in its history, environment and people, highlighted by his literary and photographic skills. He was particularly noted for his humour and will be greatly missed by the community and beyond. Above all, he will be missed by his wife, children, grandchildren and extended family and the group expressed their sincerest condolences with a minutes silence.

Aled Morris Jones SSG UK Chair seconded ER's fitting tribute noting that he will miss a knowledgeable, good humoured and supportive friend and colleague.

Mrs O'Brien had also sent a message of thanks to the SSG which read as follows

"I would like to take this opportunity to thank Tom Williams and the Team for the lovely flowers I received after losing Keith.

I would also like to thank the members for their friendship, support and readiness to help Keith whilst he was Chair of the Stakeholder committees. He had made a lot of good friends through attending various committees over the years during which he was Chair. As was said in the eulogy on the day of his funeral, his knowledge of the industry – both locally and nationally – was to be admired.

5. Trawsfynydd Site Director’s Report – Thomas G Williams

Thomas G Williams, Site Director presented his report summarised as follows:

Safety Focus

It was noted that there had been 3239 days without lost time injury as of 16 June 2025. TW stated that this was due to the continued work being undertaken to ensure the highest calibre of safety on site.

- Around 190 NRS staff on site and 100+ contractors.
- 8 apprentices currently training and 4 more expected in August

Business Planning at Trawsfynydd

Overview of projects planned at Trawsfynydd for 2025/26

- Height Reduction of the Reactor buildings
- Ponds Deplant
- Completion of the High Activity Waste Programme
- Asset Care – Relocation of the Site Security Control Room (SSCR)

Welcomed over 100 students to site to learn about nuclear history and careers with future visits to Maentwrog being planned.

Decommissioning Progress

Height reduction – contract award expected end of summer with a start date for September 2025

Ponds Deplanting – waste removed with demolition preparation underway

Assets

- SSCR operational area enclosure completed
- Effluent pipe repair project commenced
- New sewage plant installation progressing as planned

Reactor Dismantling

- Design work progressing within the key milestones

Maentwrog

Maentwrog site is now under the management of Trawsfynydd. A major maintenance plan has commenced – full outage period commenced on 5 June for 4 weeks

NRS Socio Economic Funding

TW reported on the continued financial support provided to local projects such as

- £65K to Canolfan Prysor
- Smaller grants to Caffi Largo; Phytopen; TJ Construction; Cogs y Gogs; Ty Afon.
- The fund continues to support Gwynedd Council's Recovery Programme with 58 businesses and 100+ individuals having been supported.

The Chair thanked TW for his update

Question and Answer session.

Cllr Meredydd Williams enquired if the Maentwrog site was on the open market. TW confirmed that this is not the case.

Cllr J Richards enquired as to the disposal of graphite. TW stated that options are being considered by Richard Harris, who is part of NRS's Waste Strategy team and is based in Cardiff, and that updates will be provided to members as and when received.

Elliw Williams asked if there was scope to work with local specialist regarding disposal. TW welcomed the opportunity to work locally wherever possible, however, he was currently unaware of any such local specialist in this case.

Beryl Williams requested an update on the situation with the bridge. TW confirmed that arrangements are underway for demolition as safety was paramount. He also assured members that the open and continuous dialogue with the local community as regards future developments will be maintained.

VC enquired as to current and future support for the apprentices. TW confirmed that sites across the UK utilise the support of the Energus scheme and that Trawsfynydd site intends to welcome an intake of 4 new apprentices later this year.

6. Report by the Office for Nuclear Regulation – Katie Chandler

Katie Chandler had tendered her apologies, however, in her absence, she was welcomed to the SSG as the newly appointed ONR Inspector for Trawsfynydd

7. Report by Natural Resources Wales / Environment Agency – Iwan Williams / David Wilby

Iwan Williams and David Wilby were welcomed to meeting
IW wished to apologise for not providing a written report noting that this was due to administrative difficulties. He stated that regular inspections had taken place as required and that there were no significant issues to report.
He also introduced Dave Wilby as a newly appointed EA Inspector for Wylfa who was covering the meeting on the EA's behalf.

The Chair thanked IW and DW for their attendance and update.

Question and Answer Session – none received

8. Report by the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority – Jonathon Jenkin

Jonathon Jenkin was welcomed back to the SSG.
He paid his respects to Cllr.O'Brien acknowledging his incredible knowledge, good humour, friendship and admiration across the NDA nationally.

He referred to the following updates

- Spending Review - group funding for 2025/26 is at just over £4bn, this includes increased Government funding demonstrating significant public investment in nuclear sites and facilities. Despite funding challenges, the NDA is focused on its nationally important mission to ensure the safe and efficient decommissioning of the UK's nuclear legacy, with much to deliver.
- NDA 5th Strategy will go out to consultation for a 12-week period from 7 July 2025 to 29 September 2025. Responses are welcomed.

- SSG & NDA meeting to be held on 2 July in Manchester
- The NDA celebrates its 20th anniversary this year and is hoping to hold an event locally to celebrate the unique history of Trawsfynydd. More details to follow.

Question and Answer Session

VC referred to the recent announcement by the Government regarding renewable energy and enquired if JJ could elaborate on the NDA's views. JJ stated that there is a view to deploy wind and solar energy but that there was nothing area specific to report at this moment.

9. Corporate Update NRS – Bill Hamilton

Mr Bill Hamilton, NRS Corporate Affairs Director was welcomed to the meeting and gave a brief update on corporate issues. He referred to Chapel Cross and the intention to develop an energy park at the site which may well provide a similar vision for Trawsfynydd

He also referred to a programme of local engagement events that have been ongoing for the last 18 months. A polling company has been employed to facilitate the process. One of the issues highlighted was the lack of knowledge around NRS within the local community. This has led to developing what is being described as a Deep Dive programme of events within local communities. Four sites have already taken part with another 4 to take place before the end of the year - Trawsfynydd scheduled for early September. Members were assured that further information will be provided well in advance. BH also noted that the events may well be a good avenue to discuss local concerns regarding the bridge.

Question and Answer Session

VC thanked BH for his update and kindly suggested that ensuring a mobile information stand in the Anglesey Show in August would be beneficial to gain local views.

EW noted that Cwmni Egino welcomed and supported all efforts to ensure local involvement

10. AOB

- **Election of SSG officials** – the Chair noted that the process of election will take place at the December meeting.
- **Egino** – Eiliw Williams updated members on work to date. She stated that whilst the Trawsfynydd site has not been identified for new nuclear, collaborative work around alternative developments for the site are ongoing. She offered to provide an update/ presentation on the Growth Deal programme to a future meeting of the SSG.

NDA Stakeholder Update

Please find below a brief update on main points of interest since the last meeting.

Government Update

David Peattie, Nuclear Decommissioning Authority Chief Executive Officer, has informed the NDA Chair and Board of his intention to continue to serve the NDA group as its CEO until March 2027. He has shared his plans 18 months ahead of his intended departure to allow preparations to begin to find his replacement and ensure a smooth and comprehensive handover. As the CEO role is a government appointment, a process will now be put in place to find a successor. Outreach activities

Paul Vallance, Corporate Affairs Director for the NDA, addressed the All-Party Parliamentary Group for Nuclear at the Palace of Westminster in early October. The event was attended by more than 20 parliamentarians interested in the nuclear sector. Paul updated on the following:

- The importance of decommissioning within the nuclear lifecycle.
- Resetting perceptions that decommissioning is a declining sector.
- The NDA group's significant contribution to the UK Government's Plan for Change and economic growth.
- Euan Hutton, Sellafield CEO, highlighted Sellafield's role in energy and national security.
- Seth Kybrid, Nuclear Waste Services CEO, outlined the Nuclear Transport Solutions (NTS) involvement in safe and secure transport capabilities for HALEU (high-assay low-enriched uranium). He also emphasised the critical role of the Low Level Waste Repository (LLWR) and Geological Disposal Facility (GDF) in completing the nuclear lifecycle.

The NDA group also hosted a Parliamentary reception in September at Speaker's House. The Rt. Hon. Sir Lindsay Hoyle hosted the event, with speakers including Minister Shanks MP and former energy minister Andrew Bowie MP. David Peattie gave a keynote address to more than 150 guests to celebrate the NDA's achievements and milestones, and to mark the NDA's 20th anniversary.

Engagement priorities for 2025

As you are aware, the consultation on the NDA draft **Strategy 5** was launched on 7 August and closed on 29 September. Our strategy document is published every five years and describes our high-level approach to delivering our mission. Within that, we



identify several critical enablers essential to the successful delivery of our mission including public and stakeholder engagement. Once we have analysed all the comments the final document will be produced and published in March 2026.

This year's Stakeholder Summit was held virtually on 3 November. Marking the NDA's 20th anniversary, over 250 stakeholders joined the event with input from a range of speakers and panellists. The event was broken into three sessions and included key speakers from across the NDA and its Operating Companies as well as colleagues from the nuclear regulators.

Supporting green energy development

The NDA group is working with CX Power as the strategic developer to support the delivery of the green energy hub masterplan at Chapelcross, a programme set to transform the region. The privately funded, multi-million pound, net-zero focused development, will generate several hundred high value jobs and attract skills and investment, driving growth in the local economy.

The NDA is investing £1 million to develop the masterplan for a clean energy development on land adjacent to Sellafield, known as Pioneer Park, which will drive long-term economic growth and jobs. The funding will enable local development company BEC to produce a detailed masterplan taking into account Sellafield's existing requirements.

Publications, public service and policy updates

The NDA Annual Report and Accounts 2024/25 sets out the progress we're making against our mission.

As we mark our 20th anniversary, this year's report reflects a strong year of delivery across the NDA group with continued progress on our mission: safely decommissioning our sites, managing radioactive waste, and preparing to take on new responsibilities.

Key highlights from the last 12 months include:

- Sellafield is now removing waste from all four legacy ponds and silos – a major milestone in hazard reduction.
- Nuclear Waste Services is progressing with final capping at the LLW Repository.
- Visible skyline changes across the estate, including the demolition of Sizewell A's turbine hall.
- Ongoing work to identify a suitable site and community for a Geological Disposal Facility.



- Innovation in action: sail trials for Nuclear Transport Solutions' ships and autonomous security systems at Winfrith.
- Preparations continue for the transfer of the advanced gas-cooled reactor (AGR) fleet and potential decommissioning of the Vulcan site near Dounreay.

Additionally, we've seen improvements in safety, environmental performance, and cyber security, supported by the opening of a new cyber facility to boost collaboration.

2024/25 also saw another year of significant investment in our people and communities. We had a record early careers intake in 2025 with over 420 apprentices and 300 graduates. And we saw continued support for skills, schools, and supply chain development – part of our £49m annual investment. And finally, we saw the continued ongoing delivery of our Inclusion Strategy, with progress on equality, diversity, and inclusion.

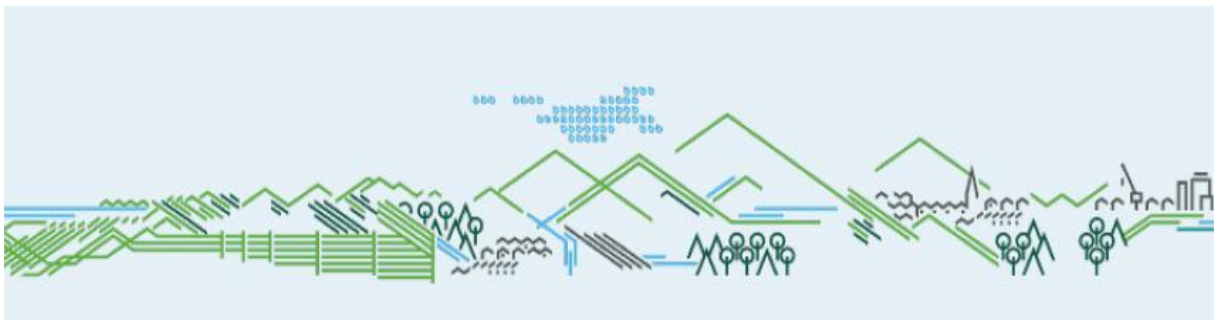

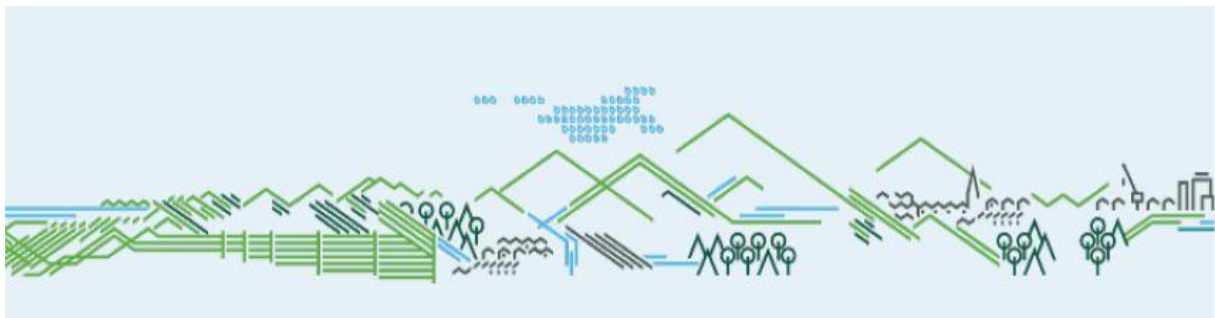
**REPORT TO THE SITE STAKEHOLDER GROUP
DECEMBER 2025**

FOREWORD

This report is issued to the Site Stakeholder Group (SSG) to provide a brief summary of the regulatory activities of Natural Resources Wales (NRW) relating to the Trawsfynydd Decommissioning nuclear site.

NRW is accountable to the Welsh Government for the environmental regulation of nuclear sites in Wales. NRW has a contractual arrangement in place which enables them to draw on the experience and resources of the Environment Agency's specialist Nuclear Regulation Group, to assist in the delivery of on-site inspection work and associated assessments.

We regulate the disposal of radioactive waste, discharges to water and conventional waste. Please see Annex 1 for further information on our role.



Introduction

This report covers the period from May 2025 to October 2025.

The Environment Agency Nuclear Regulator assigned to Trawsfynydd on behalf of NRW changed from Kate Simpson to John Madden during this period.

Inspections

There were no inspections carried out during this period due to a change in lead nuclear regulator for the site. An introductory site visit for the new lead nuclear regulator has been carried out.

Discharges

All regulated discharges, including the radioactive discharges to air and water from Trawsfynydd were within permitted limits in this reporting period.

Environmental monitoring

The environmental monitoring programme has progressed throughout the quarter. There is a minor issue related to the data submitted for lake sediment sampling that is currently being investigated – the outcomes will be reported in the next period.

Permitting

During this period NRS Ltd withdrew its application for on-site disposals of radioactive waste. We have since entered discussion with NRS Ltd to start working towards re-submission.

NRS Ltd have also submitted an application for the Disposal for Recovery of Waste to Natural Resources Wales which is currently in determination. This is an application to re-use the clean demolition waste from the proposed height reduction work and re-use on site for a lay down area to support future decommissioning activities.

Events and enforcement

We regularly review summaries of all events reported and discuss those relevant to environmental compliance with NRS Ltd as part of our routine regulation. There were no events of note during this period.

Annex 1: The role of Natural Resources Wales and the Environment Agency at nuclear sites

Operating and cleaning up nuclear sites generates radioactive and non-radioactive wastes. Our role as the environmental regulator is to ensure that the impact of those wastes on people and the environment, now and in the future, is as small as it can be. We also aim to prevent pollution, enhance the environment, and contribute to the sustainable development of the UK.

We inspect nuclear sites and assess proposals from operators, to provide assurance that the operator is complying with the limits and conditions of the permits we issue under the Environmental Permitting Regulations 2016 (as amended) and other relevant legislation and policy.

We supplement direct regulation with a partnership approach, working with the operators, the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA), and the Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR) to solve problems jointly.

We expect operators to comply fully with all relevant legislative requirements and permits. If this does not happen, we will not hesitate to use our enforcement powers to ensure that action is taken to protect the environment or to secure compliance.

In summary our objectives are to:

- Ensure that environmental permits are up to date, flexible and fit for purpose and that they drive environmental improvement
- Assess compliance with the limits and conditions of the permits
- Reduce risks to the environment and avoid creating further legacies
- Ensure that integrated waste strategies continue to improve
- Ensure that solid waste is packaged in a form suitable for disposal
- Ensure that infrastructure and assets are maintained to minimise environmental impact
- Develop guidance on Best Available Techniques (BAT)
- Influence NDA so that they provide appropriate direction to operators to minimise waste and improve environmental outcomes
- Encourage integrated management of fuel and nuclear materials so as to prevent or minimise the potential environmental impacts
- Ensure land and groundwater contaminated by radioactivity or other pollutants is managed appropriately and protect land and groundwater from further contamination
- Monitor and assess organisational change to ensure that environmental performance is maintained

2. Routine matters

2.1. Inspections

Inspections are undertaken as part of the process for monitoring compliance with:

- The conditions attached by ONR to the nuclear site licence granted under the Nuclear Installations Act 1965 (NIA65) (as amended);
- The Energy Act 2013;
- The Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974 (HSWA74); and
- Regulations made under HSWA74, for example, the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017 (IRR17) and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 (MHSWR99).

The inspections entail monitoring the licensee's actions on the site in relation to incidents, operations, maintenance, projects, modifications, safety case changes and any other matters that may affect safety. The licensee is required to make and implement adequate arrangements under the conditions attached to the licence in order to ensure legal compliance. Inspections seek to judge both the adequacy of these arrangements and their implementation.

In this period, routine inspections of Trawsfynydd covered the following:

A follow-up targeted ONR engagement was also held in the reporting period with the Trawsfynydd Safe Store Height Reduction project team following the decision to appoint the Principal Contractor (PC). The purpose of the engagement was to understand the process the dutyholder undertook in making its decision and to gain assurance that appropriate scrutiny has been applied in the selection process.

3. Non-routine matters

Licensees are required to have arrangements to respond to non-routine matters and events. Our inspectors judge the adequacy of the licensee's response, including actions taken to implement any necessary improvements.

There were no such matters or events of significance during the period.

4. Regulatory activity

We may issue formal documents to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements. Under nuclear site licence conditions, we issue regulatory documents, which either permit an activity or require some form of action to be taken. These are usually collectively termed licence instruments but can take other forms. In addition, inspectors may take a range of enforcement actions, to include issuing an enforcement notice.

- No licence instruments, enforcement notices or enforcement letters were issued during this period.
