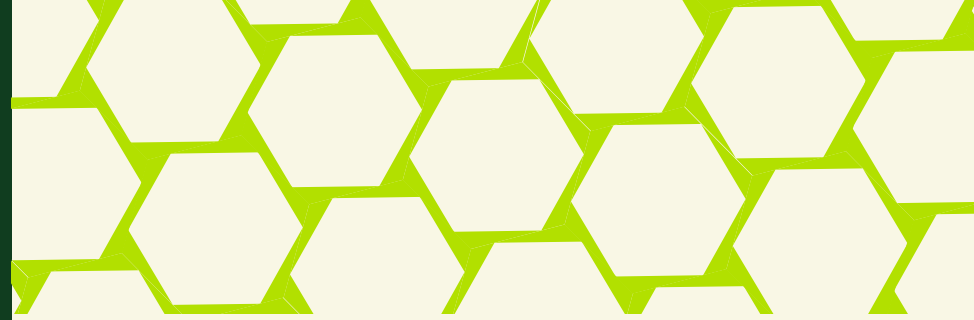

Decommissioning Projects

- Physical work in Pond complex complete
- Turbine Hall de-cabling nearing completion – minor excavations required to access final cables
- OTC demolition well advanced – completion of work schedule for end of March



Waste Projects – Wet Waste Retrieval

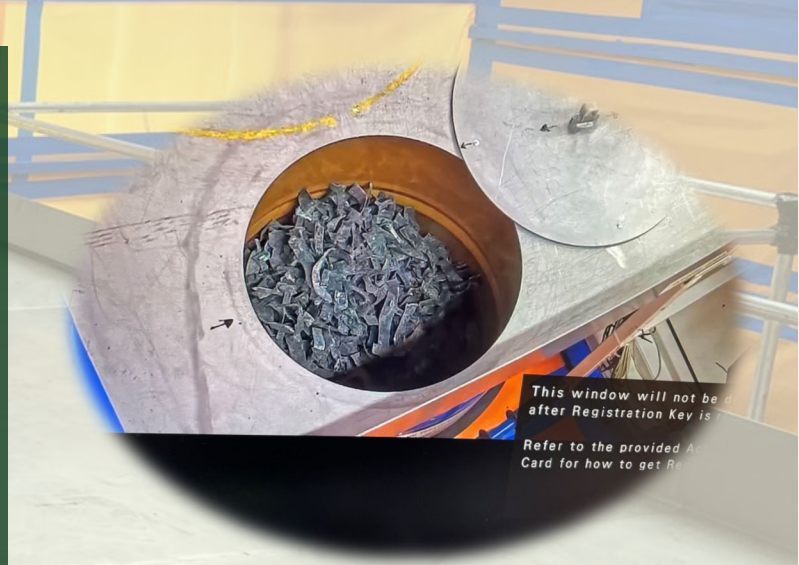
Vacuum Fill House activities are drawing to a close for this phase of work. Installation complete, site acceptance activities are ongoing with the expectation to be completed this financial year.

The facility will now be cycled routinely until the drying facility becomes available.



Waste Projects – Early Fuel Element Debris (FED)

- Vault 3 work complete. 5 drums removed and sorted. Samples sent for analysis

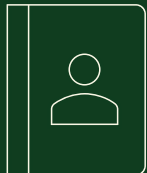

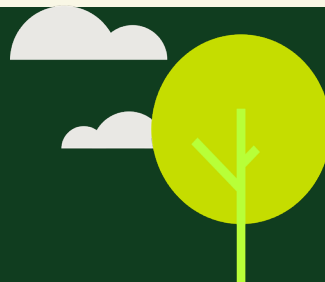

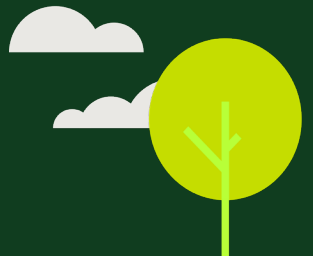
