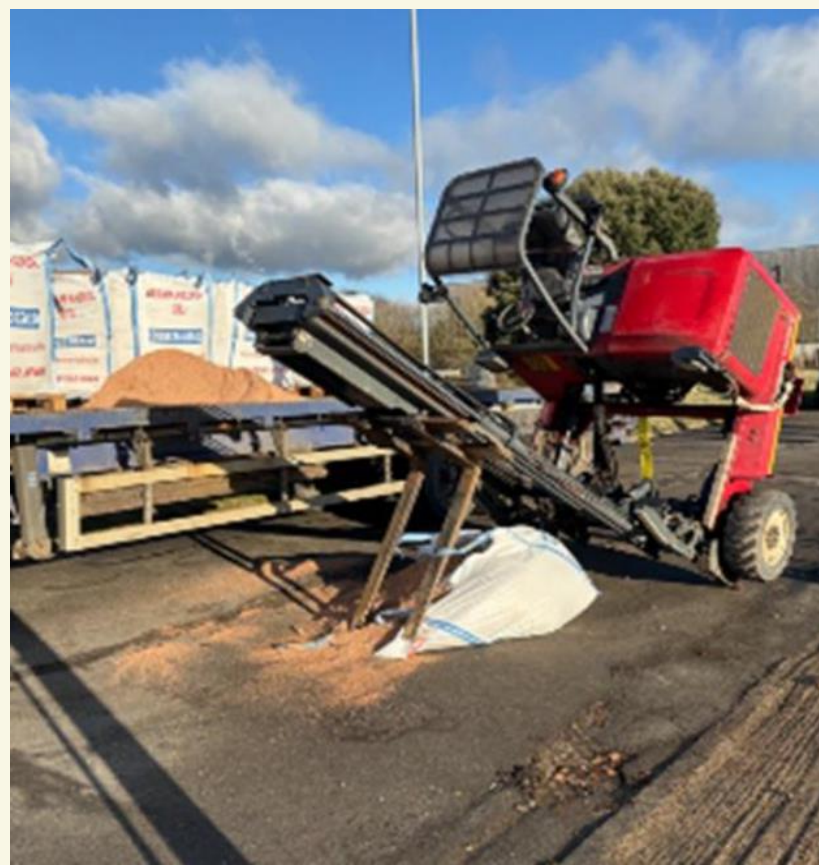

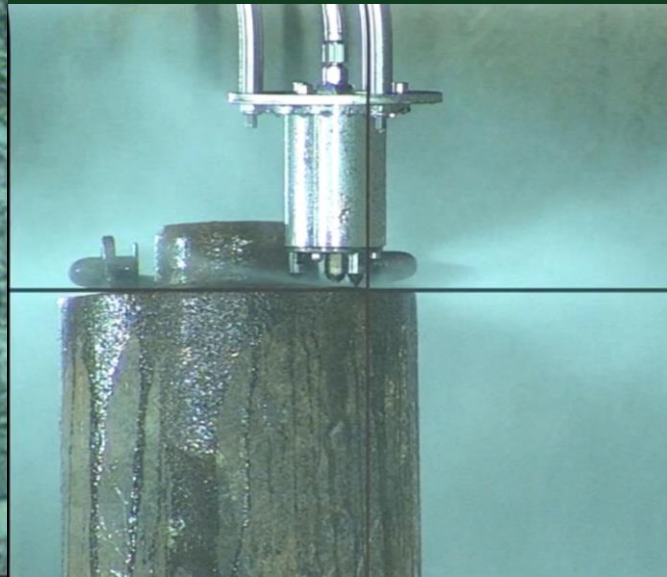


Site activities



Waste update

- Both vault 1 and vault 3 waste is being retrieved by site teams using remote handling plant, some of which is still in commissioning. Approximately 35T are scheduled to be retrieved this year.
- 4 low-level waste shipments are planned for 2025/26.

16 packages are planned to be sent to the ISF waste store in 2025/26. To date, 3 packages have been completed.

Site Projects

- Following the company spending settlement for 2025/26, contracts to process blower house waste were terminated until funding becomes available.
- Facilities constructed and equipment purchased will be put to good use at Berkeley and the wider NRS fleet.
- Work continues addressing deteriorating assets on site through the asset care programme. The main focuses this year are spring hangar storage and the fire and security systems.

Sustainability and wellbeing at Berkeley

- Site apprentices attended a careers fair at SGS college, talking to students about what it's like to work for NRS and opportunities in the Nuclear Sector.
- Site staff have voted to support Springboard Opportunity Group, with fundraising events this year. Springboard is a local daycare provider for children with learning disabilities, physical disabilities and complex medical needs.
- No Mow May has begun at Berkeley, to encourage wildflower growth and support biodiversity on site. This campaign will be extended throughout June, July and August.

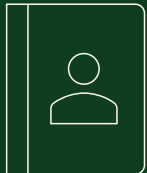

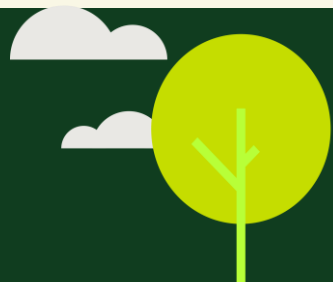
