During times of power outage, communication is a significant issue. Personnel who have already arrived on site following call out can take their direction from DECC. For those who are off site, there is little opportunity to contact them if mobiles and landlines are not functioning – apart from reverting to manual operation. This is something that is currently being addressed and will be exercised later in the year. NRS currently uses an emergency communications system (Critico) that has a 2 way responder pager function that is very resilient but if the mobile phone networks are all down, there is little chance to utilise this. NRS has access to radios and one satellite phone but these are not routinely with the on call personnel as not practicable. This is an ongoing issue and		Complete

		one that is challenging for all organisations. Dounreay Resilience Team continues to consider the potential options.
