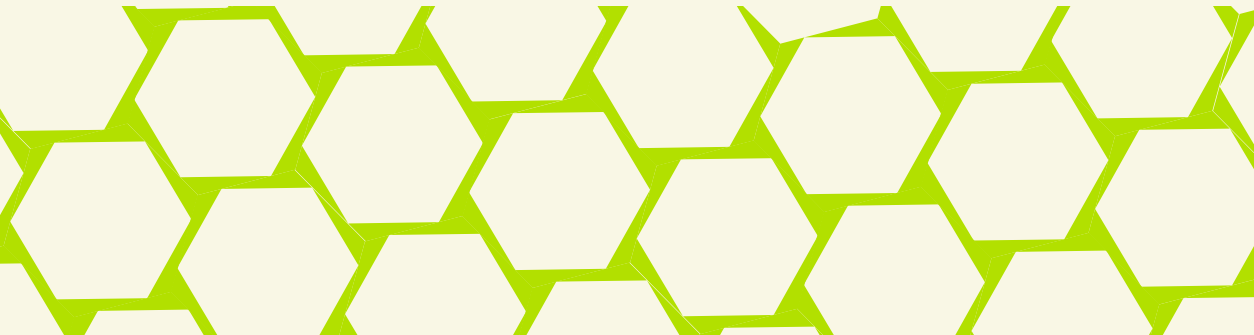

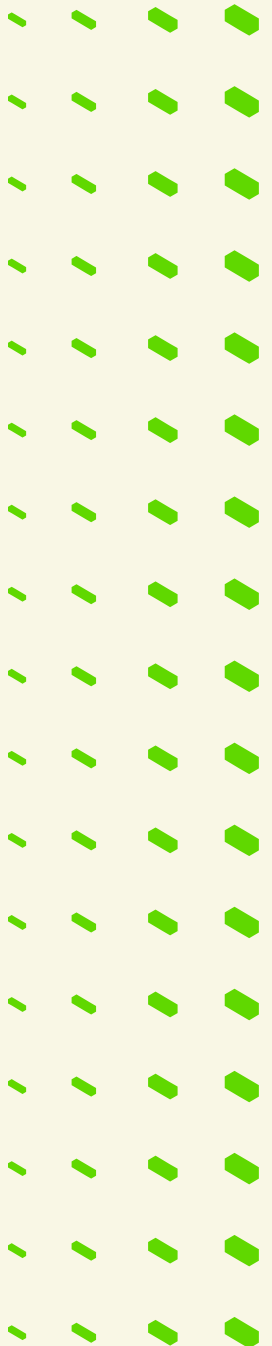

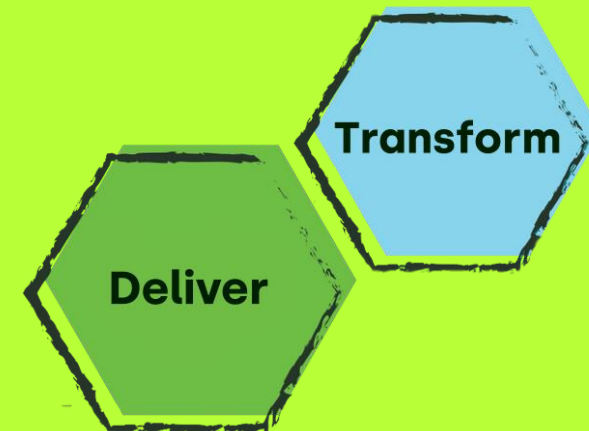

- Prosiect System Troshaen drydanol wedi cyrraedd cam sylweddol wrth i UKPNS baratoi i gychwyn gwaith sifil.
- Prosiect yn symud ymlaen o cyfnod cynllunio i cyfnod gweithredol.

Next phase

- Creu llwybr ceblau newydd ar draws y safle.
- Cychwyn ar waith cloddio sylfaen yr is-orsaf 11kV.

Cam nesaf:

- Bydd system newydd 11kV yn disodli'r hen cyflewnad 132kV, gan wella diogelwch, effeithlonrwydd a dibynadwyedd.
- Gallu i ynysu y Neuadd Dyrbin a cefnogi'r cam nesaf o'r cynllun datgomisiynu.
- Paratoi Wylfa ar gyfer y cam nesaf o'i daith datgomisiynu.



Electrical overlay system

Progress to date

- EOS project reaches a key milestone as UKPNS prepares to start on-site civil works.
- Project moves from planning into active delivery.

Next phase

- Creation of the new cable route across site.
- Excavation of the 11kV substation footprint begins.



Looking ahead

- New 11kV system will replace the legacy 132kV supply, improving safety, efficiency, and reliability.
- Enables full isolation of the Turbine Hall and supports continued decommissioning progress.
- Positions Wylfa for the next stage of its decommissioning journey.

- Concrete coring has begun between the Fueling Machine Maintenance Bay and D4F5.
- Work is focused on forming a new man accessway through the reinforced concrete wall.

Next phase

- Completion of coring and creation of the full doorway opening.
- Preparation of the new access route for safe use during operations.

Looking ahead

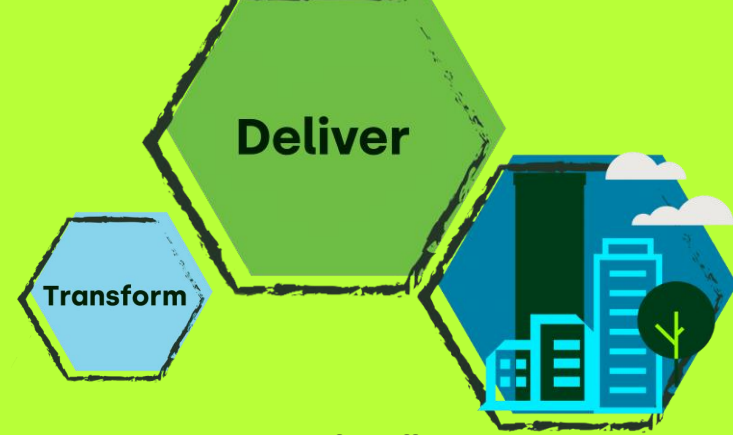
- The new accessway will remove the need for vertical ladder use in this area.
- This will improve safety, ease of movement, and overall efficiency during the operational phase.

Diweddariad Safle / Site update:

Monitro deunyddiau sgaffaldio/ Monitoring scaffolding materials



Cynnydd hyd yma

- Mae Wylfa wedi ailwrpasu dros 100 tonnell o ddeunyddiau sgaffaldio o'r adeiladau adweithydd gan ddefnyddio monitor deunyddiau arbenigol.
- Gwirio dros 18 mis wedi cynnwys:
 - 10+ tonnell o offer
 - 70+ tonnell o waith dur
 - 40+ tonnell o fyrddau sgaffaldio
- Canlyniadau hyd yma:
 - 60 tonnell o waith dur wedi'i ailgylchu ac aildddefnyddio ar y safle
 - 30 tonnell o fyrddau sgaffaldio wedi'u haildddefnyddio
- Mae hyn wedi lleihau gwastraff, torri costau, a chefnogi nodau cynaliadwyedd y safle.

Camau nesaf

- Parhau i asesu deunyddiau drwy'r monitor ar gyfer eu haildddefnyddio ac ailgylchu'n ddiogel.
- Rhannu dysgu gyda safleoedd eraill sydd â diddordeb yn yr un dull.

Edrych ymlaen

- Bydd y monitor deunyddiau yn parhau i fonitro, gan helpu i wreiddio arferion cynaliadwy a chost-effeithiol.



Progress so far

- Wylfa has repurposed over 100 tonnes of scaffolding materials from the reactor buildings using a specialist materials monitor.
- Checks completed over 18 months include:
 - 10+ tonnes of fittings
 - 70+ tonnes of steelwork
 - 40+ tonnes of scaffold board
- Outcomes so far:
 - 60 tonnes of steelwork recycled and reused on site
 - 30 tonnes of scaffold boards reused
- This has reduced waste cut costs, and supported the site's sustainability goals.

Next steps

- Continue assessing materials through the monitor for safe reuse and recycling.
- Share learning with other sites interested in adopting the same approach.

Looking ahead

- The materials monitor will remain in operation, helping embed sustainable, cost-effective practices.

- Mae'r uwchraddiad yn darparu dibynadwyedd a gwydnwch hirdymor, gan gefnogi gweithrediadau'r safle i'r dyfodol.
- Bydd diogelwch, hygrychedd ac effeithlonrwydd gwell yn elwa'r safle wrth symud ymlaen.

Progress so far

- New brackets and pipework installed.
- New calorifier control panel installed.
- More efficient systems have been fitted, improving performance and reducing ongoing maintenance needs.
- The works have enabled a new accessible toilet to be introduced.

Next steps

- Routine checks and monitoring will continue to ensure the system remains compliant and optimised.

Looking ahead

- Completion of the upgrade has significantly reduced Legionella risk across the site.
- The upgrade provides long-term reliability and resilience, supporting site operations well into the future.
- Improved safety, accessibility, and efficiency will benefit the site as it progresses through its next phases.

Cynaliadwyedd / Sustainability

Cynllun plannu coed

- Lansiodd Wylfa ei ymgyrch Plannu Coeden yn ddiweddar, gan gynnig coed am ddim i staff a chontractwyr.
- Nod yr ymgyrch yw hybu bioamrywiaeth, cefnogi ecosystemau lleol ac annog gweithredu amgylcheddol.
- Casglwyd dros 300 o goed, gyda llawer wedi'u rhannu ymlaen â ysgolion a grwpiau cymunedol.
- Mae'r ymateb cryf yn adlewyrchu ymrwymiad y tîm i gynaliadwyedd a gofal amgylcheddol.
- Bydd pob coeden a blannir yn cefnogi bywyd gwyllt, aer glanach a mannau gwyrddach yn y gymuned.
- Mae'r ymgyrch hefyd yn cefnogi nodau Llywodraeth Cymru i ehangu coetiroedd erbyn 2030.

Tree planting initiative

- Wylfa has launched its Plant a Tree campaign, offering free native and fruit tree saplings to staff and contractors.
- The aim is to boost biodiversity, support local ecosystems and encourage positive environmental action.
- Over 300 saplings were collected, with many shared with schools, and community groups.
- The strong uptake reflects the team's commitment to sustainability and environmental stewardship.
- Each tree planted will support wildlife, cleaner air and greener community spaces.
- The campaign also supports Welsh Government woodland-expansion ambitions for 2030.

Ail-leoli degeiriau gwenyn

- Mae tîm Wylfa wedi ail-leoli tegeiriau gwenyn gwarchodedig a ddarganfuwyd yn ystod arolygon cynnar ar gyfer y System Trydanol Newydd.
- Datblygodd arbenigwyr amgylcheddol a'r tîm prosiect gynllun adleoli i'w diogelu rhag tarfu gan waith adeiladu sydd ar ddod.
- Galluogodd cynllunio cynnar i'r gwaith gael ei integreiddio'n esmwyth i'r rhaglen.
- Mae'r tegeiriau bellach wedi'u hadleoli'n llwyddiannus a byddant yn cael eu monitro dros y misoedd nesaf.
- Disgwylir iddynt flodeuo eto ym mis Mai, gan gadarnhau adleoliad llwyddiannus.
- Mae'r gwaith hwn yn tynnu sylw at ymrwymiad Wylfa i gynnwys cynaliadwyedd a diogelu'r amgylchedd wrth gyflawni'r prosiect.
- Mae'r gwaith yma'n cyfrannu at etifeddiaeth amgylcheddol hirdymor Wylfa.

Bee orchid relocation

- The Wylfa One team has safely relocated protected Bee orchids found during early Electrical Overlay System surveys.
- Environmental specialists and the project team developed a relocation plan to avoid disruption from upcoming construction.
- Early planning allowed the move to be integrated smoothly into the programme.
- The orchids have been successfully relocated and will be monitored over the coming months.
- They are expected to flower again in May, confirming successful relocation.
- This work highlights Wylfa's commitment to embedding sustainability and protecting the environment while delivering the project.
- The relocation contributes to Wylfa's long-term environmental legacy.

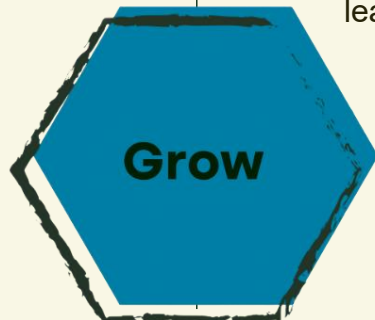

Good Neighbour Funding 2025/2026

Wylfa Socio-Economic Panel has awarded funding to several local projects through the Good Neighbour scheme.

Grants support community wellbeing, sustainability, and local opportunities.

Each site has £6,000 available.

Projects supported this year:

- **Rhosybol Community Council** – £2,600 VE & VJ Day commemorative events; approx 1,000 attendees; strong use of local businesses.
- **Hyfforddiant Parys Training** – £1,000 Supporting redevelopment of the Copper Bins building into small business units.
- **Bodedern U10s Football** – £900 Training kit and equipment promoting equality, unity, and bilingual youth sport.
- **Llannerchymedd Junior Football Club** – £900 Football kit supporting equal access and team identity for young players.
- **Llanfechell Community Council** – £1,000 Supporting an archaeological dig, bringing the community together and celebrating local heritage.

Funding totals: £6,400

Helpu i greu cymunedau cynaliadwy / Helping to build sustainable communities

Cafodd buddsoddiad **Cyngor Cymuned Llanbadrig** hwb gyda £10,000 o gyllid MRS tuag at brosiect gwerth £214,000 i wella caeau chwarae Cemaes, ynghyd â datblygu ardal chwarae gynaliadwy a Maes Chwarae Aml-Ddefnydd (MUGA) sy'n hygyrch i bawb.

Mae'r trigolion wedi bod yn rhan allweddol yn dylunio'r gofod, ac fe fydd yr ardal hefyd yn gweithredu fel lleoliad ar gyfer cynnal digwyddiadau cymunedol.

Mae'r prosiect yn symud yn ei flaen yn dda ac maent yn gobeithio ei gwblhau erbyn y Gwanwyn.

Llanbadrig Community Council's investment was boosted with £10,000 NRS funding towards a £214,000 project to improve the Cemaes playing fields as well as develop a well-designed sustainable play area and Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA), that's accessible to all.

Local residents have been actively consulted and the area will also serve as a space to host community events.

The project is progressing well and hope to be complete by Spring.

Helpu i greu cymunedau cynaliadwy / Helping to build sustainable communities

Wrth i Ynys Môn baratoi i gynnal Eisteddfod Genedlaethol yr Urdd 2026 ym mis Mai, mae prosiect STEM dwyieithog newydd yn dod â gwyddoniaeth, creadigrwydd a diwylliant ynghyd i ddisgyblion ar draws yr ynys.

Gyda £20,000 o gyllid gan NRS, bydd yr Urdd, mewn cydweithrediad â Sbarduno a Menter Môn, yn darparu rhaglen o weithdai STEM ymarferol dwyieithog gyda dros 20 o ysgolion lleol. Bydd y gweithdai'n archwilio ac yn dysgu trefn wyddonol y lliwiau, a bydd y disgyblion yn cynhyrchu cân enfys newydd yn Gymraeg.

Bydd fideos animeiddiedig hefyd yn cael eu creu gan y disgyblion hŷn ynghyd â jig-so enfys 3D ar gyfer arddangosfa, tra bydd Côr Ieuencid Môn yn perfformio'n fyw yn seremoni agoriadol Eisteddfod yr Urdd 2026.

As Anglesey prepares to host the 2026 Urdd National Eisteddfod in May, a new bilingual STEM project is bringing science, creativity, and culture together for pupils across the island.

With £20,000 NRS funding, the Urdd, in collaboration with Sbarduno and Menter Môn, will deliver a programme of hands-on bilingual STEM workshops with over 20 local schools. The workshops will explore and teach the scientific colour order, the pupils will produce a new Welsh language rainbow song.

Animated music videos will also be created by the older pupils along with a 3D rainbow jigsaw for display whilst Côr Ieuencid Môn Youth Choir will showcase a live performance at the 2026 Urdd Eisteddfod opening ceremony.

Cyngor Sir ynys Mon, Cynllun Adnewyddu Gogledd Mon -

- Buddsoddiad o £351k gan yr NDA (a reolir gan NRS) wedi sicrhau £8m ychwanegol gan Fargen Twf Gogledd Cymru.
- Yn cefnogi datblygu adeiladau masnachol newydd ac yn creu gwerth economaidd a chymdeithasol o £20m.
- Ailwampio'r terminal morol i greu gofod masnachol o ansawdd uchel a chyfleusterau gwell, gan adfywio'r glan môr.
- Bydd deg uned fusnes newydd yn Amlwch yn cryfhau gwasanaethau lleol ac yn cefnogi mentrau sy'n wynebu'r gymuned.
