Safety share



- The site exceeded 2 years without any lost time accident in December 2025
- An individual suffered a sprained ankle while removing protective clothing in January 2026. They returned to work after 2 days. Actions to reduce the potential for a repeat event are in progress



Waste update 2025/26

- Both vault 1 and vault 3 waste is being retrieved by site teams using remote handling plant, some of which is still in commissioning.
- Approximately 41T has been retrieved this year against the target of 37T
- 3 out of 4 low-level waste shipments have been completed so far
- Further work is needed on vault 3 retrieval equipment

Berkeley funded projects to date: £83,782.34

A total of 9 Projects supported in FY25/26

5 Good Neighbour projects have been supported

- Cam Sports Club – £2,000 towards the purchase of a turf groomer
- Severn Area Rescue Association - £1,570 towards a helmet communication system
- The Keepers Wotton Area Community Hub – £1,328.39 towards the purchase of electronic alert buttons
- Whittington Park Youth Football Club - £1,032.08 towards purchasing winter jackets
- Pauls Place Southwest – £1,334.87 towards radio/podcast equipment

4 Projects above £2,000 have been supported

- Berkeley Books – £51,219 towards installation of solar panels and a heat pump for the community hub
- Cotswolds Community Shed – £8,206 to help with the relocation and purchase of container units
- Sladewood Academy – £10,000 towards creating an accessible playground for the school and local community
- Wickwar playing fields – £7,092 towards the installation of an all-weather pump track
