Safety Compliance & Environment

What's Gone Well:

- ✓ Safety – There have been no first aid incidents or accidents sustained at Bradwell since the last LCLC
- ✓ There have been no significant Security events at Bradwell since the last LCLC
- ✓ Bradwell Beach Clean on 18th September in collaboration with the Marine Conservation Society
- ✓ Signage around the Site Car Parks and Nature Trail approach is in the process of being updated
- ✓ Successful Security ONR witnessed exercise, 'Adequate' rating

Look Ahead:

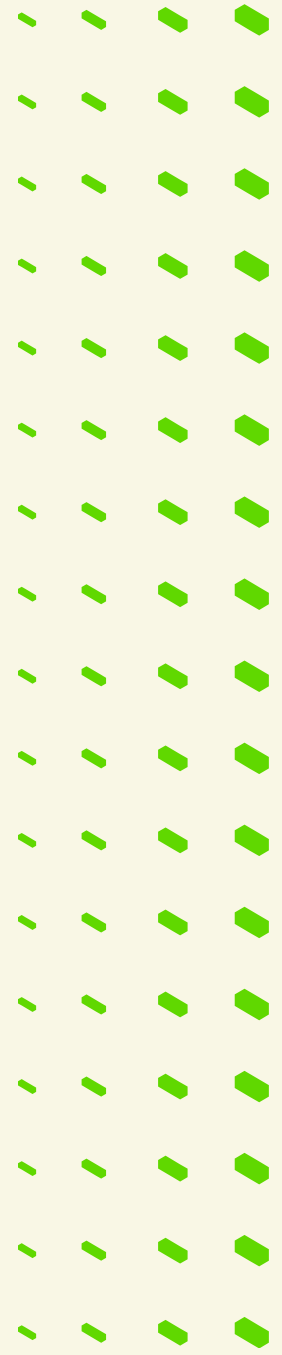
- Preparing for the 2027 mobilisation, ensuring training and risk assessments are produced for the works being undertaken



Asset & Infrastructure Care Projects

Works completed Sept 25 to April 26:

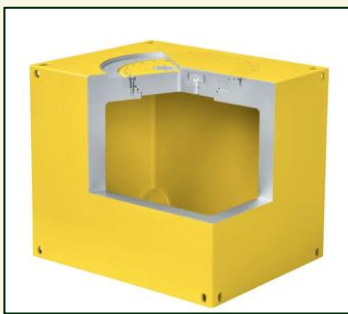
- Sept 25 – Short duration mobilisation
 - Upgrade of security welfare facilities and undertaking routine ISF maintenance
- Feb-Mar 26 – 2 x Two-week duration mobilisations
 - Completion of approx. 250 planned maintenance routines.
 - Including but not limited to; Maintenance of ISF Crane, LOLER inspections, Electrical & Lighting Maintenance, Security Systems Maintenance, Pedestrian Gate upgrade, Monitoring Upgrades, Air Con unit deep cleans, Cabin Roof repairs, Drain Surveys.



Waste Operations

Intermediate Level Waste (ILW):

- Import of 1x Dungeness DCIC into Bradwell ISF containing sand and gravel waste.
- Export of 2x Bradwell DCICs containing ILW desiccant waste generated during Bradwell decommissioning. >2.6 Tonnes of waste dispatched for thermal treatment removing long term storage and management burden from site.
- Ongoing inspections and compliance activities within ISF



"Type VI," DCIC

Low Level Waste

- 1 x incinerable waste shipment and 1x VLLW shipment dispatched from Bradwell. Waste comprised 145 packages of concrete/rubble and secondary wastes generated during outage works in 2025.
- HiRAM (gamma spec) monitoring campaign completed in September enabled waste routing and shipment direct from Bradwell avoiding road transport of waste to Sizewell.
- LLW generation on site now limited to small quantities of secondary waste generated during ISF operations until next outage.
- Bradwell LLW inventory returned to zero after consignment of outage waste.

Other Issues

- Hazardous waste consignment dispatched from site on 30/03/26.
